**CAUTION:** Allow time for your vehicle to cool down prior to installation. When working on or under your vehicle proceed with caution. Wear protective safety equipment; eye goggles and gloves to ensure a safe installation. aFe recommends professional installation on our products.

**Step 1:** Support the vehicle on jack stands disconnect the negative battery terminal from battery.

**Step 2:** Remove the O2 sensors between the FRONT & REAR of the OE cats.

**Step 3:** Remove the (x2) nuts securing the catalytic converter to the stock exhaust system.

**Step 4:** Remove the (x3) nuts from the catalytic converter.

**Step 5:** Remove the (x4) 15mm bolts securing the catalytic converter to the stock exhaust manifold and now you can remove the catalytic convert.

**Step 6:** Remove the rear catalytic converter.

**Step 7:** Install aFe rear catalytic converter.

**Step 8:** Re-install the (x2) bolts & nuts to the exhaust system do not tighten.

**Step 9:** Re-Install the OE catalytic converter to the OE exhaust manifold secure with the (x4) bolts and the (x3) nuts do not tighten.

**Step 10:** Tighten the (x4) bolts tighten the (x3) nuts tighten (x2) bolts & nuts

Step 11: Re-Install 02 sensors between the FRONT & REAR of the cats.

Step 12: Re-check all your work.

**Step 13:** Remove vehicle off jack stands.

**Step 14:** Re-check all bolts/nuts clamp after 50-100 miles.
