- Retain factory parts for future use.



Installation will require the following tools: 5/16" Socket or Nut Driver, T25 Torx Bit, & Flat-Head Screw Driver

Refer to Figure A for steps 1-3

- Step 1. Loosen the airbox cover retaining screws using a T25 Torx bit and remove the airbox cover.
- Step 2. Loosen the clamp securing the intake tube to the intake plenum.
- Step 3. Disconnect the flexible breather tube from the intake tube.



Refer to Figure B for step 4

Step 4. Remove the intake tube and air filter from the airbox.





Refer to Figure C for steps 5-7

Step 5. Install aFe air filter, air filter clamp, rubber grommet and aluminum smog pump adapter on the aFe intake tube. Tighten the air filter clamp.

Step 6. Install the hump coupling and supplied clamps on the aFe intake tube, do not tighten the clamps at this time.

Step 7. Install aFe intake tube assembly into vehicle. (It is easiest to first seat the hump coupling on the intake plenum before guiding the "filter end" of the tube into the airbox. When installed completely, the air filter will be located below the OE air filter plunger. The groove in the tube will seat on the airbox and lid.) Tighten the hump coupling clamps.



Refer to Figure D for steps 8-9

Step 8. Connect the flexible breather tube to the aluminum smog pump adapter. Install the airbox cover and tighten the retaining screws. Installation is now complete.

Damage from abuse, improper cleaning, improper oil and improper installation or from open flame is not covered by this limited warranty. In the event of a defect of an aFe product within the period covered by this limited warranty, the purchaser can return the product to the dealer where it was purchased or send the product to aFe at the the back after obtaining а Return address listed on Good Authorization (RGA) number from aFe. The original register receipt will be required as proof of purchase. Purchaser will be entitled to a refund of the entire purchase price or a replacement of the product at aFe's discretion. Purchaser shall be responsible for the cost of shipping the defective product to aFe. An RGA number can be obtained by calling aFe customer service. Products shipped without an RGA number will be refused. A refund or replacement of the product shall be the sole remedy available under this limited warranty and aFe shall not be responsible for consequential or incidental damages.
