Description: Taillight Part Number:321210 Application:08-10 Dodge Challenger



Tools Needed Flat head screwdriver T20 Torx 10mm Socket and ratchet (Only for models with upgraded sound system)



Use your screwdriver to pop the plastic locks from under the light



Remove the 4 plastic wing nuts from the inside of the trunk



Remove the plastic covers located at the end of the light by pulling downward (there is one on either side if the light)



Using your T20 Torx remove the screw located in the pocket where you removed the plastic cover from the last step



Pop the light up giving a gentle tap on both sides. Un-clip the plug in the center from the vehicle.



Remove the harness from the back of the stock light. Pull the light bulbs our of the harness leaving the reverse bulb in.



Plug the pigtails coming out of the Anzo light in to the sockets. Be sure to match the black wire on the same sides of the plug



Twist the sockets back into place



Remove the plastic wing nut from behind the outer tail light. Pull the carpet back away from the vehicle



Remove the plastic wing nut and the light plug from behind the carpet

Reverse the steps above to re-install the center portion of the tail light



Pull the taillight out



Wipe the inside area clean with a towel. Stick the two resistors to the car out over the way of the light.



Plug the resistors into the back of the light and reverse the steps for installation. Do this for both sides.



Check for proper function of the taillight.
