The air filter is reusable and should be cleaned using the Airaid Filter Tune-Up Kit periodically.

## Installation Instructions. Read Me!



1. Disconnect **negative** battery cable. Using supplied T-20 security bit, remove factory mass air sensor (save for later use).



**4.** Using a 10mm socket, remove the five bolts and plate from engine compartment.




7. Install Airaid Cool Air Dam assembly in engine compartment using the four supplied bolts, and washers.




**2.** Remove factory filter minder and grommet.



3. Loosen hose clamps on factory intake tube assembly and remove from engine. Unsnap factory air box assembly and remove from vehicle.



 Assemble Airaid Cool Air Dam panels using the supplied #6 screws, washers and nuts.



 Using the three supplied <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub> -20 button head bolts and washers, install the air filter adapter on the Airaid Cool Air Dam.



8. Using the supplied 8/32 allen head bolts and washers, install factory mass air sensor in Airaid intake tube. (*Note: Sensor must be installed in direction shown in picture.*)



**9.** Install factory rubber grommet and air filter minder in Airaid intake tube.



**10.** Install supplied hump hose and two #64 hose clamps onto large end of Airaid intake tube. (<u>Note</u>: Leave hose clamps loose until final assembly.)



**11.** Install coupler and two #60 hose clamps onto small end of Airaid intake tube. (*Note: Leave hose clamps loose until final assembly.*)



**12.** Install Airaid tube assembly onto engine. Position coupler and hump hose and tighten hose clamps. Connect wire harness to mass air sensor. (<u>Note</u>: There should be a gap between the Airaid intake tube and the air filter adaptor.)



- **13.** Install the supplied Airaid filter on the air filter adaptor. Install the supplied weather strip on the Airaid Cool Air Dam. (*Note: Start from one corner and work your way around to insure proper alignment of weather strip.*)
- **14.** Double check your work to be certain that all nuts, bolts, and clamps are securely fastened.
- **15.** Reconnect the negative battery cable.
