### Installation Instructions. Read Me!



1. Disconnect the negative battery cable. Loosen the 2 factory hose clamps located at the Mass Air Flow (MAF) meter.




**2.** Unplug the MAF meter and remove the meter from the factory intake tube.



3. Remove the factory air filter lid and base from vehicle as an assembly. (Hint: pull straight up on the air filter base to remove, there are no bolts; just friction mounts).




**4.** Remove the five 10mm bolts that secure the factory air filter housing platform and remove.



5. Position the two Airaid Cool Air Dam panels and fasten them together with the small #6 screws, nuts & washers provided.



**6.** Install the 7 ¼" rubber trim onto the side of the air dam as illustrated.



7. Install the black plastic filter adapter using the three \(^14\)-20 x \(^12\)" button head bolts and washers provided.



8. Position the Airaid Cool Air Dam Intake system in place of the factory air box & secure the Airaid system to the factory mounting pad using the four supplied 6mm bolts and washers. (Caution: over tightening may distort the cold air dam!)





9. Slide the factory MAF meter into the black plastic filter adapter. Tighten hose clamp. (Note: The factory clamp / rubber bushing must be in place on the inlet to the MAF meter.) Reconnect the factory intake tube, and tighten clamp.



10. Mount the Airaid Premium Air Filter onto the black plastic filter adapter and tighten hose clamp. Press supplied weather stripping along the top edges of the Airaid cold air dam; assure that it is fully seated along the edges. (Hint: *Begin at a corner and work toward the ends*).

- **11.** Check for any foreign objects or debris it the intake path.
- **12.** Double check your work to be certain that all nuts, bolts, and clamps are securely fastened.
- **13.** Reconnect the negative battery cable!
