

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

3" BULL BAR 2011 SILVERADO HD 2500-3500 & 2011 SIERRA HD 2500-3500 B35-4011 / 35-4011

1	Bull Bar	8	10mm ID x 26mm OD x 3mm Flat Washers
1	Driver/Left Frame Bracket	4	12-1.75mm x 35mm Hex Head Bolts
1	Passenger/Right Frame Bracket	4	12mm Lock Washers
4	10mm x 30mm Hex Head Bolts	4	12mm Hex Nuts
4	10mm Lock Washers	8	12mm ID x 29mm OD x 3mm Flat Washers
4	10mm Hex Nuts		





PROCEDURE:


- 1. REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION.
- 2. NOTE: It may be necessary to remove/relocate front license plate and license plate bracket. It is not required, but strongly recommended. If local Prov. / State law requires a license plate, license plate relocation kit is available.
- 3. From underside of vehicle, remove the two bolts holding the Driver factory tow hook, then remove tow hook from vehicle. **NOTE:** This Bull Bar is not compatible with factory tow hooks, so you will not be reinstalling factory tow hooks back onto vehicle. Determine driver and Driver Frame Brackets. **NOTE:** Refer to Figure above for bracket configuration. Position Driver side Frame Bracket to the outside of the frame rail and secure using the included (2) 12mm x 35mm Hex Head Bolts, (2) 12mm lock Washers, (2) 12mm Hex Nuts, and (4) 12mm Flat Washers (Fig 1). Snug but do not tighten at this time.
- 4. Repeat steps for Passenger side Frame Bracket.
- 5. With help position & loosely attach Bull Bar to brackets using the included (4) 10mm x 30mm Hex Head Bolts, (4) 10mm Lock Washers, and (4) 10mm Flat Washers (Fig 2).shows Passenger side Snug but do not tighten at this time.
- 6. Level and adjust Bull Bar, then tighten all hardware at this time.
- 7. Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

To protect your investment, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish.

For stainless steel: Aluminum polish may be used to polish small scratches and scuffs on the finish. Mild soap may be used also to clean the Product.

For gloss black finishes: Mild soap may be used to clean the Product.
