
To ensure your hardtop fits properly, you must be able to adjust your Jeep's windshield, door hinge and tailgate surfaces. Failure to make proper adjustments may result in leaks or wind noise.










Remove Soft Top


If there is a soft top installed on your vehicle, you must remove it.




3 Remove Tailgate Retainers

Roll the Tailgate Retainers on each side of the tailgate opening until they release from the vehicle body.

There is a rubber Mucket Seal on top of the belt rail near the tailgate opening behind the door openings. Make sure this seal remains in place on both sides of the vehicle.









Two people are required to install the top on the vehicle.



Install Rear Shell

Lift the Rear Shell onto the vehicle and line up the holes in the shell with the mounting holes in the body.






Secure Rear Shell – 4 Door Vehicle


Install six (6) 5/16"-18 x 1" Bolts, twelve (12) 5/16" Fender Washers and six (6) 5/16-18 Nylock Nuts through the holes in the beltline ange.


Install a Hex Bolt in the holes in each front corner of the shell with a Rubber Spacer between the top and the body.




Secure Rear Shell – 2 Door Vehicle

Install six (6) 5/16"-18 x 1" Bolts, twelve (12) 5/16" Fender Washers and six (6) 5/16-18 Nylock Nuts through the holes in the beltline ange.











Install Threaded Studs in **Cockpit Cover**


Use a at screwdriver to install a Threaded Stud in the four (4) locations in the Cockpit Cover.





Install Cockpit Cover


Place the Cockpit Cover on the vehicle, rear edge rst, then lay the front edge down on the windshield. You may need to pull the cover toward the rear to engage the seal. Slip the Threaded Studs through the holes in the sport bar. Install the Turn Knobs on the Studs.






If your vehicle does not have openings in the sport bar cover above the doors, you will need to cut holes in the cover to access the holes in the sport bar. If this is the case, press on the cover to locate the holes in the bar. Use a utility knife to cut a 5/16" hole in the cover.






Full Door Alignment Check

If you have full doors, they must sit at least 1/4" inside the rain gutter on the vehicle in order to ensure a tight seal and to prevent leaking.




Install Tailgate Guard

Press the Tailgate Guard onto the rear edge of the Tailgate. Work across from the right side of the vehicle to the left.



Check Rear Window Adjustment

The rear window alignment may have shifted during shipping. If its necessary to realign it, use a phillips screwdriver and 7/16" wrench to loosen the screws. Center the window and retighten the screws.





Disconnect the Quick Disconnect before removing the Cockpit Cover.




Locate the Wiring Harness in the parts kit. The leads are marked "Rear Defrost", "Lights", and "Ground".

Connect the Wiring Harness to the Quick Disconnect ting under the carpet in the Cockpit Cover.

The Defrost and Light Switches in the Cockpit Cover are pre-wired.


The yellow switch turns on the Defroster.



Thread Wiring Harness under Sport Bar Cover

Unzip the sport bar cover and route the Wiring Harness along the sport bar toward the windshield.


Zip the sport bar cover closed.






15 Remove Passenger Sun Visor


Use a phillips screwdriver to remove the two screws that secure the passenger side Sun Visor. Set the visor and screws aside to be reinstalled later.



Remove Molded Corner Panel and A-Pillar Panel

Remove the push fastener that holds the Molded Corner Panel in place. Set the fastener and panel aside to be reused later. Then remove the A-Pillar Panel.







Thread Wiring Harness through Dash

Pull the panel along the side of the dash away.


Route the Wiring Harness from the sport bar down along the A-Pillar and under the dash into the footwell.





Thread Wiring Harness through Fire Wall


Continue to route the Wiring Harness along the route of the other bundled wires through grommet in the rewall and into the engine compartment.





19 Install Spade Connector

Press the Spade Connector on the end of the power line on the Wiring Harness.






Disconnect the battery before WARNING installing the Fuse Connector.

Install Brass Fuse Connector

Route the Wiring Harness along the engine compartment to the accessory connection point for power source when the key is on (Fuse CB1 Ignition off accessory power) in the fuse box. Install the Brass Fuse Connector. Connect the Spade Connector to the Brass Fuse Connector.

Connect the ground on the Wiring Harness to the ground off the battery.



Reinstall Moldings and Sun Visor

Tuck the Wiring Harness in and reinstall the panel along the side of the dash. Then reinstall the A-Pillar Molding and the Molded Corner Panel. Reinstall the Sun Visor.
