










Locate the Top Cart Front Strut and two (2) of the Long Foam Tubes in the parts kit. Slide the sleeves over the strut and center them with a 2" space between them.






Install Short Foam Tubes on Rear Strut - Top Cart

Locate the Top Cart Rear Strut and the two Short Foam Tubes in the parts kit. Slide the sleeves onto the strut and center them with a 2" space between them.




3 Assemble Top Cart Struts

Orient the Front, Rear and Side Struts to each other. Slide them together and line up all the holes.



Secure Front and Right Side Strut - Top Cart


Slide the Right Corner Hook onto the Front Strut. Place a 1/2-13 Jam Nut over the hole in the Front Strut. Install a Top Cart Braking Caster through both struts, the hook and into the Jam Nut.




Secure Rear Strut to Top Cart Assembly

Place a Top Cart Caster without a brake through the larger holes where the Side and Rear Struts join and secure it with a 1/2-13 Jam Nut. Then install a 1/4-20 x 1.5" Hex Bolt, a 1/4" Washer and a 1/4-20 Hex Nut.

Repeat this procedure with the other Side Strut / Rear Strut Assembly.






Install Corner Hook Rubber Pads - Top Cart


Locate the Corner Hook Rubber Pads in the parts kit. Clean the flat area on the Corner Hooks.

Orient the Corner Hook Rubber Pads to fit squarely on the Corner Hooks. Remove the backing from the pads and press them firmly onto the Corner Hooks.




Install Left Front Braking Caster and Corner Hook - Top Cart

Slide the Left Corner Hook onto the Front Strut. Slide the end of the Left Side Strut into the end of the Front Strut Assembly. Place a 1/2-13 Jam Nut over the hole in the Front Strut. Install a Top Cart Braking Caster through both struts, the hook and into the Jam Nut. Securely tighten all hardware.




Assemble Dividers - Door Cart


Slide a Long Foam Tube over one half of each pair of Dividers. Slide the sleeve up and around the bend. Press the Divider halves together. Assemble five (5) Dividers.



Install Angle Legs and Casters on Door Cart Rear Strut

Locate the Angle Legs and Rear Strut in the parts kit. Slide the Angle Legs into the ends of the Rear Strut and align the holes. Install a Door Cart Caster in each set of holes with a 3/8-16 Acorn Nut. Do not tighten the nuts at this time.






Install Door Cart Pan


Orient the Door Cart Pan so that the bottom hole along the side is 3" from the bottom of the pan. Use 1/4-20 x 1.5 Truss Head Screws, 1/4" Washers and 1/4-20 Hex Nuts to secure the pan to the Angle Legs.

Tighten the Truss Head Screws then tighten the Acorn Nuts on the casters.



Install Rubber Strips

Clean the top of the mounting ridges. Place the rubber strips on the top of the mounting ridges, over the truss head screws and center. Peel the backing a little at a time and press firmly into place. Apply uniform pressure for thirty (30) seconds.

The maximum load for WARNING the Door Cart is 235

Install Dividers in Door Cart

Insert the Dividers into the holes along the sides of the Cart Pan. The ends of the Dividers should fit securely into the mounting holes.





Store taller doors toward the back of the Door Cart with shorter doors toward the front.




Removing your OEM Hardtop

Release the levers that secure the SunTops to the windshield. Release the knobs that secure the SunTops to the rear deck. Release the Levers. Remove the SunTops from the vehicle.











Removing your Bestop Hardtop

Release the knobs that secure the Sun Roof to the vehicle. Remove the Sun Roof.









Removing your Hardtop

Use the T40 Torx Wrench to remove the six (6) Torx Bolts that secure the 2 Door Hardtop or the eight (8) Torx Bolts that secure the 4 Door Hardtop.


Carefully store the bolts to be used when reinstalling the top.






15 Install Strap on Top Cart

Orient the Top Cart Strap with the buckle facing the rear of the Top Cart. Wrap the straight end of the strap around the Rear Strut in the space between the two Foam sleeves. Pull it toward the buckle in the middle of the strap without twisting. Thread the end of the strap through the buckle.





CAUTION Four or more people are required to lift the hardtop safely.




Slide the top back slightly, but leave on the vehicle.

Place the Top Cart against the rear of the top with the Rear Tube toward the top.


Position Right and Left Corner Hooks on the cart under the rear flange of the hardtop for maximum support.

Hook the strap to the front of the hardtop. Pull the strap as tight as possible.






CAUTION Four or more people are required to lift the hardtop safely.




Use the Side Struts as handles to lift the hard top and Top Cart off the vehicle and move toward the rear. Slowly place the top in its normal position down on the ground next to the vehicle. Recheck that the strap is secure.






Two or more people are required to lift the hardtop safely.

DO NOT allow the hardtop to rock backwards while lifting.



Lock the Front Brake Casters. Slowly lift the front of the hardtop until it is completely resting on the Top Cart Casters. Do not allow the hardtop to rock backwards as it approaches the full upright position.




Lock Front Brake Casters



19 Storing your Hardtop

Release the Front Brake Casters and roll the hardtop/ cart assembly into position for storage. Once the cart is in this position, again lock the front casters.

Roll door cart into top cart and load with doors. Center the cart in the top.
