

Installation Tips

Before you begin installing this assembly, read all instructions thoroughly.

For a smooth fit:

For ease in installation, the product should be installed at temperatures above 72° F. Below this temperature, the fabric may contract an inch or more, making it difficult to fit to the vehicle. It is normal for fabric to contract and wrinkle when stored in the shipping carton. Within a few days after the installation, the fabric will relax and the wrinkles will disappear.

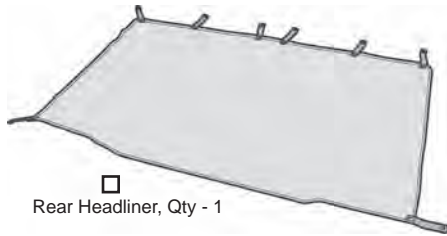

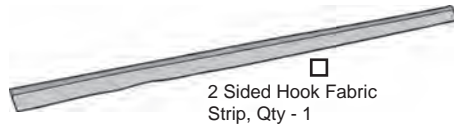

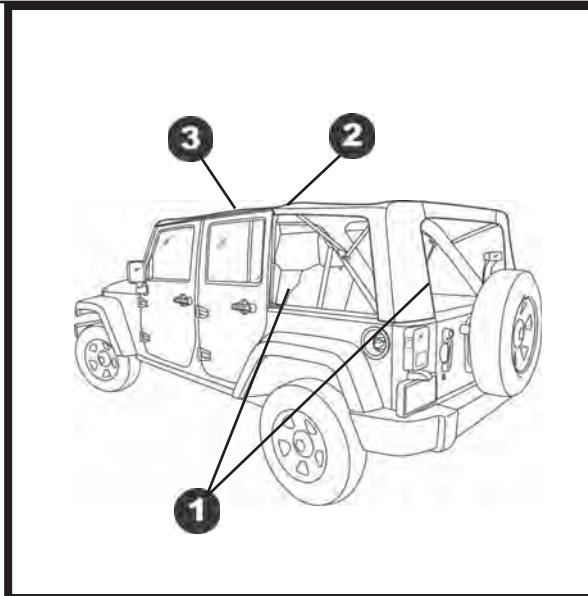

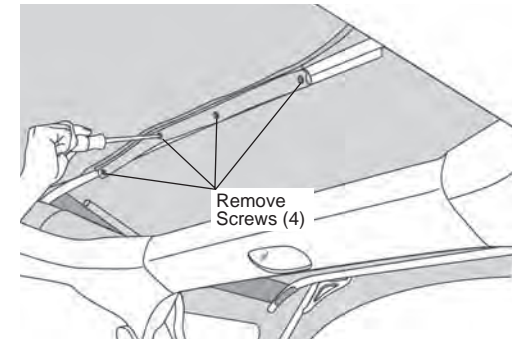
1 Remove Rear and Side Windows

Remove the Rear and Side Windows on the Top.



2 Remove Top from Center Bow

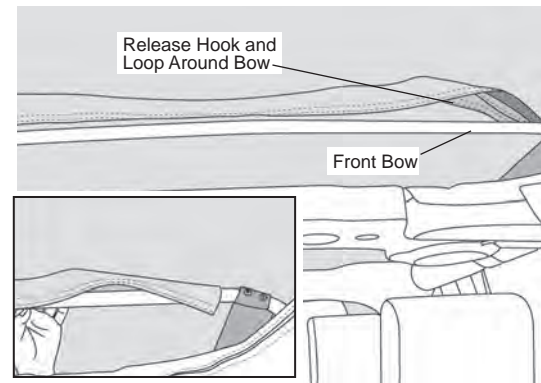
Remove the four (4) screws that fasten the Top to the Center Bow. Set them aside to be reinstalled later.



Remove Screws (4)

3 Release Top from Front Bow 2007 – 2009 Vehicles Only

Release the hook and loop flap around the Front Bow.



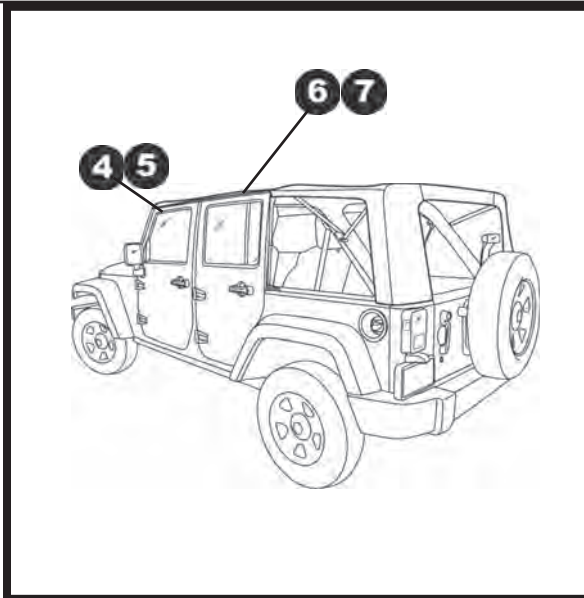
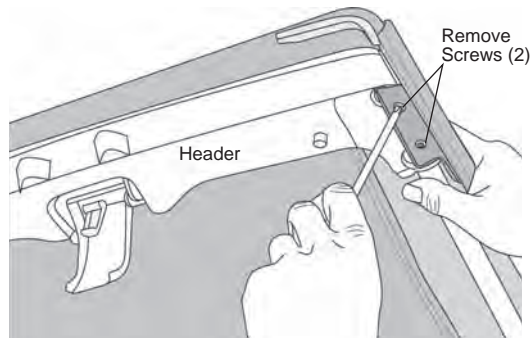
Release Hook and Loop Around Bow

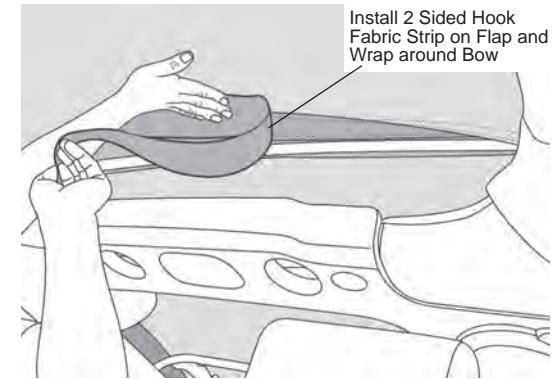
4 Remove Top from Header

Remove the two (2) screws that secure the Top to the Header on each side. Set them aside to be reinstalled later.



6 Install 2 Sided Hook Strip 2007 – 2009 Vehicles Only

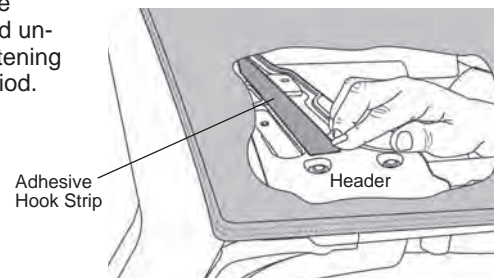
Fasten the 2 Sided Hook Strip to the loop on the flap around the Center Bow. Close the flap and the 2 Sided Hook Strip around the bow.



5 Install Adhesive Hook on Header

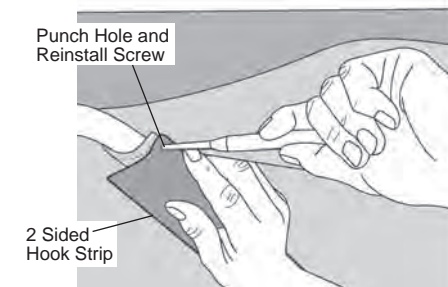
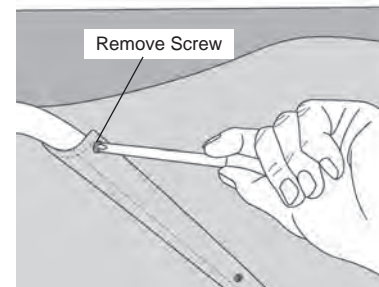
Cut a length of Adhesive Hook Strip to match the loop strip sewn to the front of the Headliner. Peel the backing off the Adhesive Hook Strip a little at a time and press it firmly into place on the Header as shown. Repeat on both sides of the vehicle.

NOTE Allow 72 hours for the adhesive to set. Avoid unnecessary fastening and unfastening of the Headliner during this period.



7 Install 2 Sided Hook Strip 2010 and Newer Vehicles Only

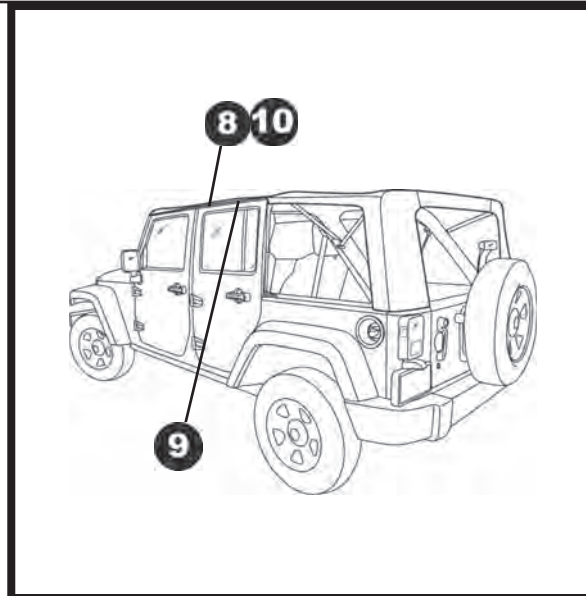
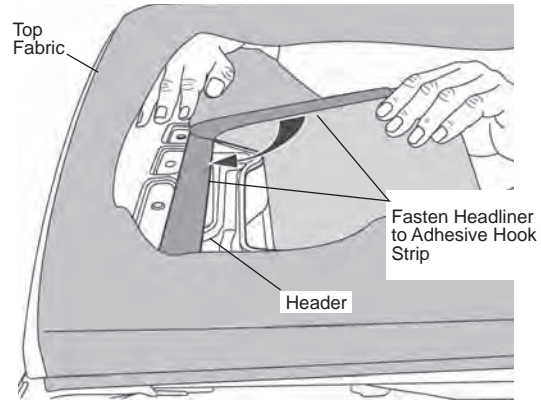
To secure the 2 Sided Hook Strip to the Center Bow on 2010 and newer vehicles, remove one flap screw at a time. Align the top (loop) side of the Hook Strip to the top of the fabric flap. Punch a small hole in the Hook Strip and reinstall the screw. Repeat for all four (4) screws. Make sure that the hook side of the 2 Sided Hook Strip faces outward.

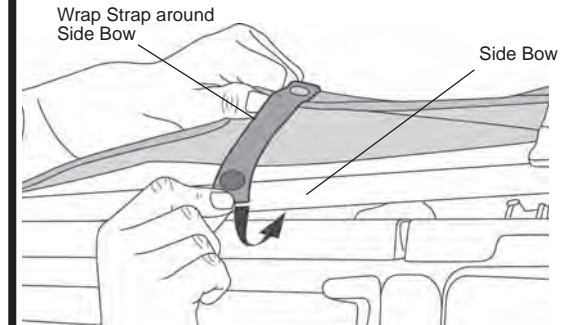
8 Secure Front Headliner to Header

Center the Front Headliner on the vehicle. Fasten the loop strip sewn to the front of the Front Headliner to the Adhesive Hook Strip installed on the Header.



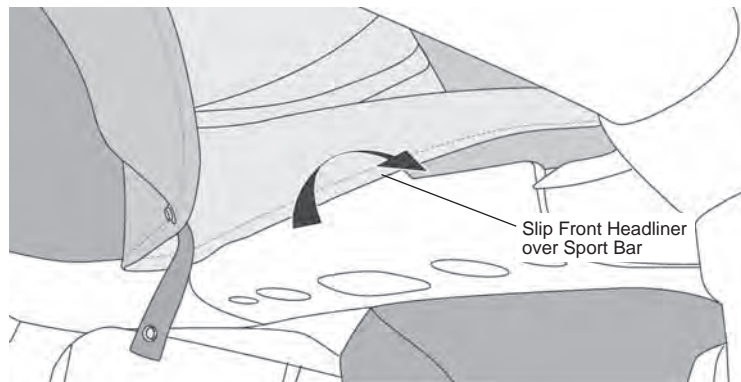
10 Secure Front Headliner Strap

Wrap the front strap on the Front Headliner around the Side Bow and snap it to itself. Repeat on both sides.



9 Slip Front Headliner over Sound Bar

Slip the Front Headliner Fabric between the Sound Bar and the Top Fabric.

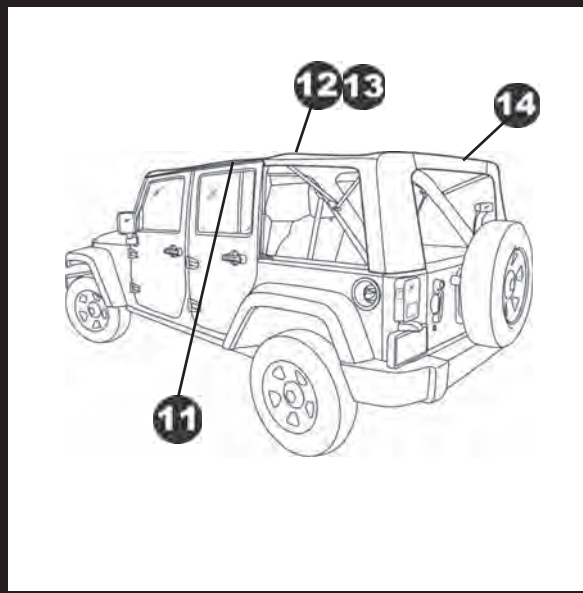
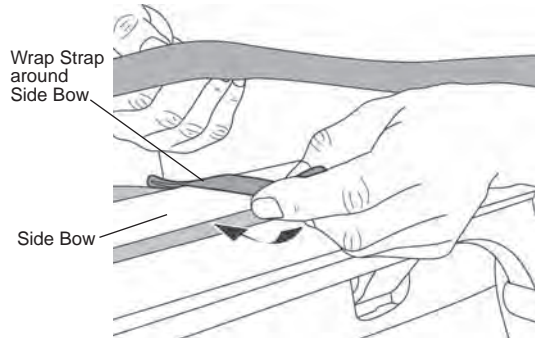

11 Secure Rear Headliner Strap

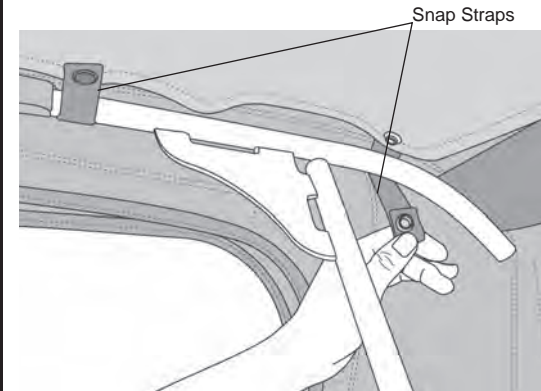
Slip the Headliner between the Sport Bar and the Top Fabric.

Wrap the rear strap on the Front Headliner around the Side Bow and snap it to itself. Repeat on both sides.



14 Secure Rear Straps

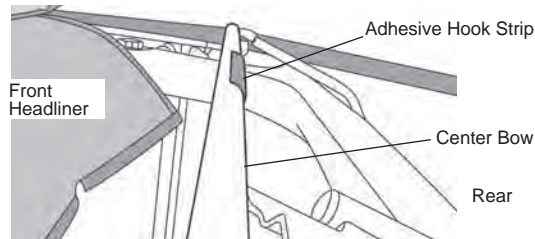
Wrap the six (6) rear straps of the Rear Headliner around the Rear Bow and snap them to themselves.



12 Install Adhesive Hook on Center Bow

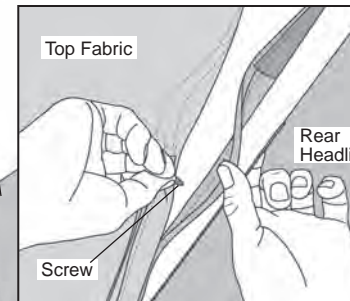
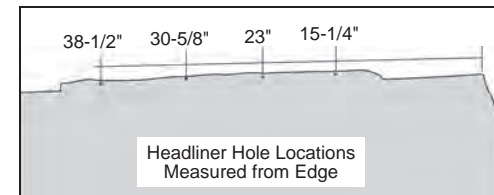
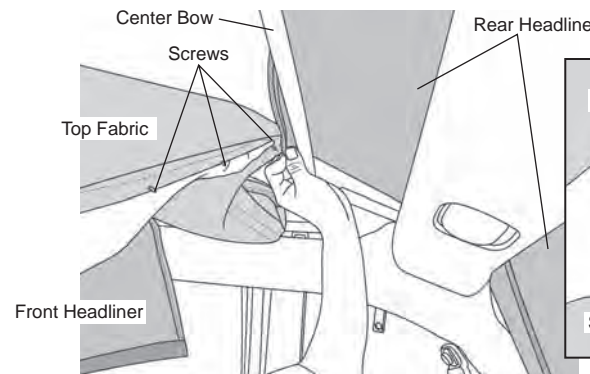
Cut a length of Adhesive Hook Strip to match the loop strip sewn to the Headliner. Use the loop strip in the Headliner as a guide to install Adhesive Hook Strips on the Center Bow. Peel the backing off the Adhesive Hook Strip and press it firmly into place.

NOTE Allow 72 hours for the adhesive to set. Avoid unnecessary fastening and unfastening of the Headliner during this period.



13 Secure Rear Headliner to Center Bow

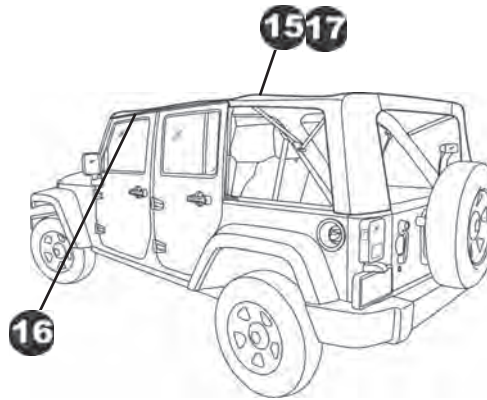
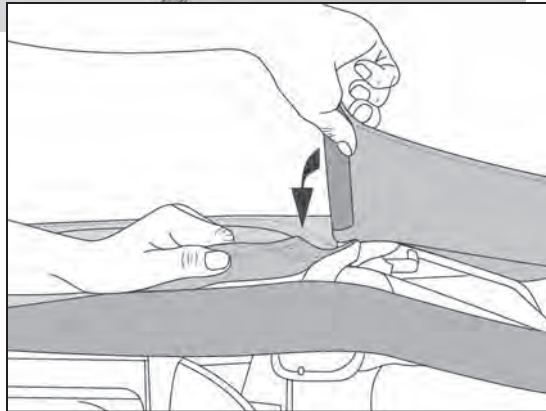
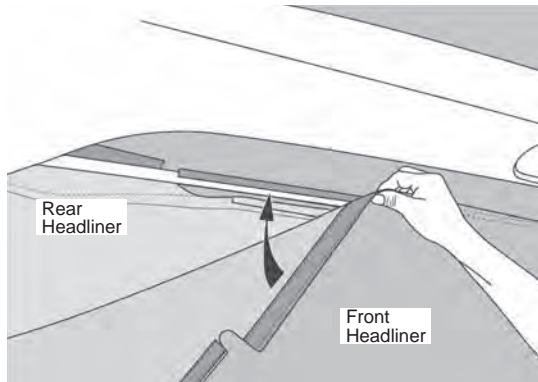
Place the Rear Headliner over the Center Bow and align the holes. Use the screws removed in Step 3 to secure the Top flap and the Rear Headliner to the Rear Bow.

15 Secure Front Headliner to Rear Headliner

Pull the Front Headliner back and fasten it to the Adhesive Hook Strip installed on the Center Bow. Then fasten it to the Rear Headliner.



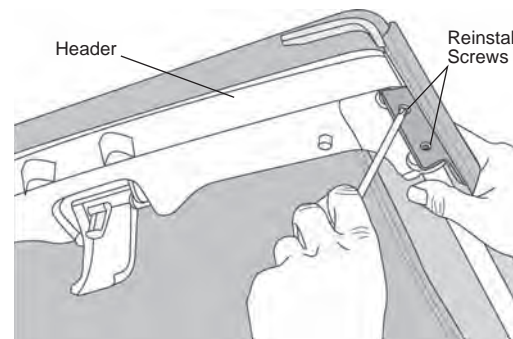
17 Secure Front Headliner to Center Bow

Press up on the Front Headliner to secure it to the Adhesive Hook Strip installed on the Center Bow in Step 6 and 7.



16 Reinstall Top to Header

Reinstall the two (2) screws removed in Step 5 to secure the Top to the Header on each side.

Care and Maintenance of your Bestop Product

Your Bestop product is made of the finest materials available. To keep it looking new and for the maximum possible wear, it will need periodic cleaning and maintenance.

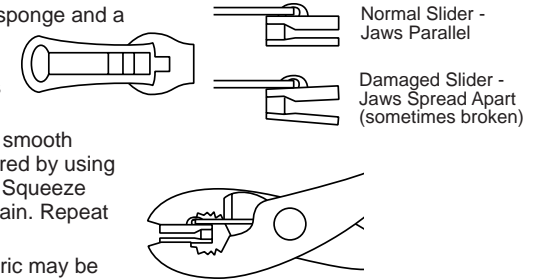
Washing: The fabric should be washed often using soap, warm water and a soft bristle brush. Rinse with clear water to remove all traces of soap or use Bestop-recommended Bestop Cleaner and Bestop Protectant. Bestop Cleaner and Bestop Protectant are specially formulated to provide a total cleaning and protection system. Bestop Cleaner will not harm vehicle finish, is biodegradable and environmentally friendly. Bestop Protectant protects against UV-fading, cracking and hardening.

Windows: Keep windows clean to avoid scratching. DO NOT use a brush on the windows! Wash with a water-soaked cloth or sponge and a mild dishwashing detergent or use Bestop-recommended Bestop Vinyl Window Cleaner, which safely cleans and protects vinyl windows while helping prevent UV damage. NEVER WIPE THE WINDOWS WHEN THEY ARE DRY. Be careful when cleaning snow or frost from the vinyl windows since they are easily scratched and may crack at low temperatures. DO NOT roll the sides or rear window in cold weather. The windows become stiff and will crack.

Zippers: Keeping the zipper cleaned and lubricated with a silicone lubricant will help prevent damage and keep the zippers in a smooth working condition. If a zipper opens behind the slider, the slider may have been spread apart. This problem can usually be repaired by using an ordinary pair of pliers to bring the sides back into parallel. Return slider to the end of the zipper in the normal Open position. Squeeze lightly at first and test the zipper. If the zipper continues to remain open squeeze more firmly with the pliers and try the zipper again. Repeat this procedure until the zipper operates correctly.

Water: Seeping through at the seams may be stopped by applying 3-M Scotchgard® on the inside of the seams. Rips in the fabric may be repaired with Bondex® iron on patches. Iron the patches to the Inside of the top, carefully following the Bondex® instructions.

Snaps: Keep snaps cleaned and lubricated with silicone to help prevent snaps from sticking to the studs. If a snap does become stuck to a stud, use a screwdriver and GENTLY pry apart to prevent permanent damage to the snap or the top fabric.
