INSTALLATION / SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS 🗓

Step 1

Locate the vehicle taillight wiring harness connectors (A). The connectors will be similar to those on the custom wiring harness. Separate the connectors from the taillight housing taking care not to damage the locking tabs. **Note:** Lowering of the vehicle spare tire may ease the installation.

Step 2

Insert the custom wiring harness end with yellow wire between the separated connectors. Make sure the connectors are fully inserted with locking tabs in place (B).

Step 3

When in use, route the 4-flat to the center of the vehicle and out of the trunk. When not in use, roll up and store in a convenient, out of the way location inside the trunk. Secure any loose wires with the provided cable ties.

Step 4

Reinstall all items removed during install. Install the provided 4-flat dust cover to help prevent corrosion.
