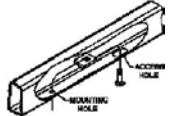

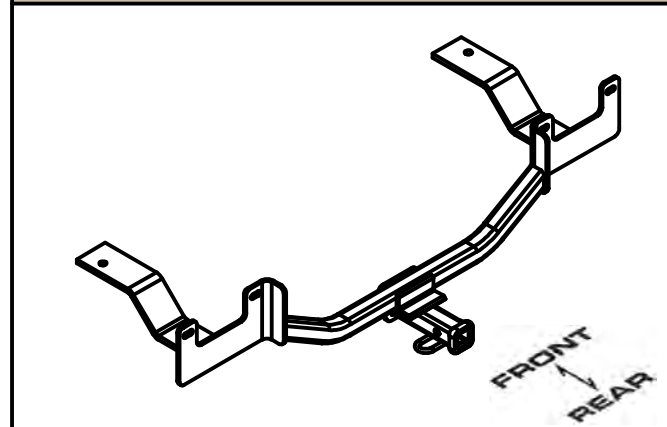

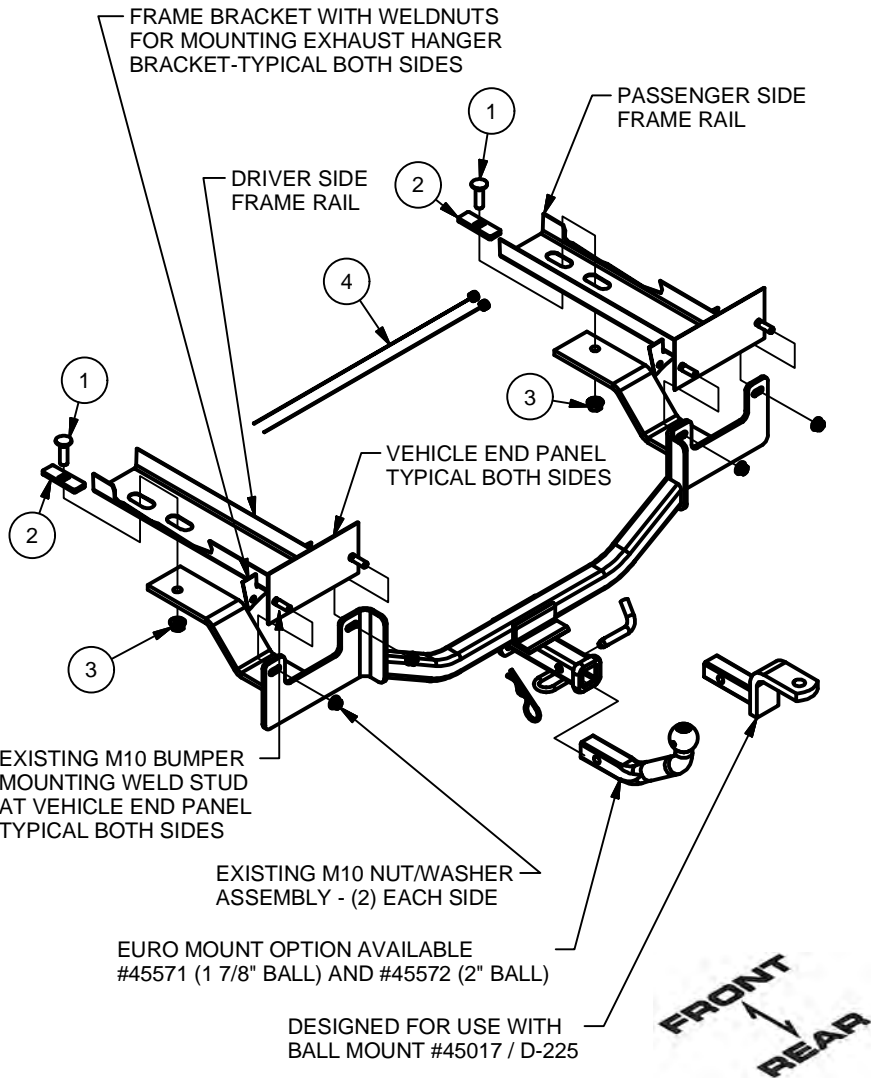

1. Lower exhaust by removing 2 bolts which attach exhaust hanger bracket to frame bracket.



2. Remove (2) bumper mounting nut/washer assemblies from each side, one on each side of frame rail.

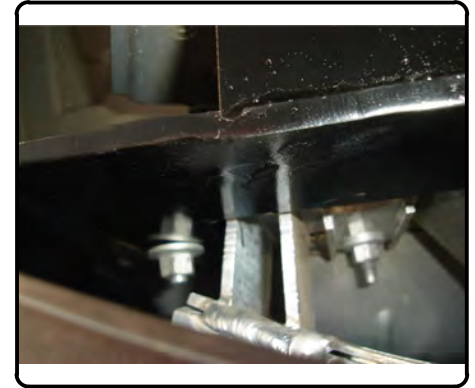
3. If present, cut off stud from passenger side frame rail.



4. Fishwire carriage bolt and block up through forward slot and down through attaching slot as shown.



5. Raise hitch into position such that side arm feeds between tailpipe and exhaust hanger bracket. Raise exhaust and hitch together. Position slots in hitch side plates over bumper mounting studs and allow carriage bolts installed in step 3 to feed through holes in hitch side arms. Attach M10 nut/washer assemblies removed in step 2.



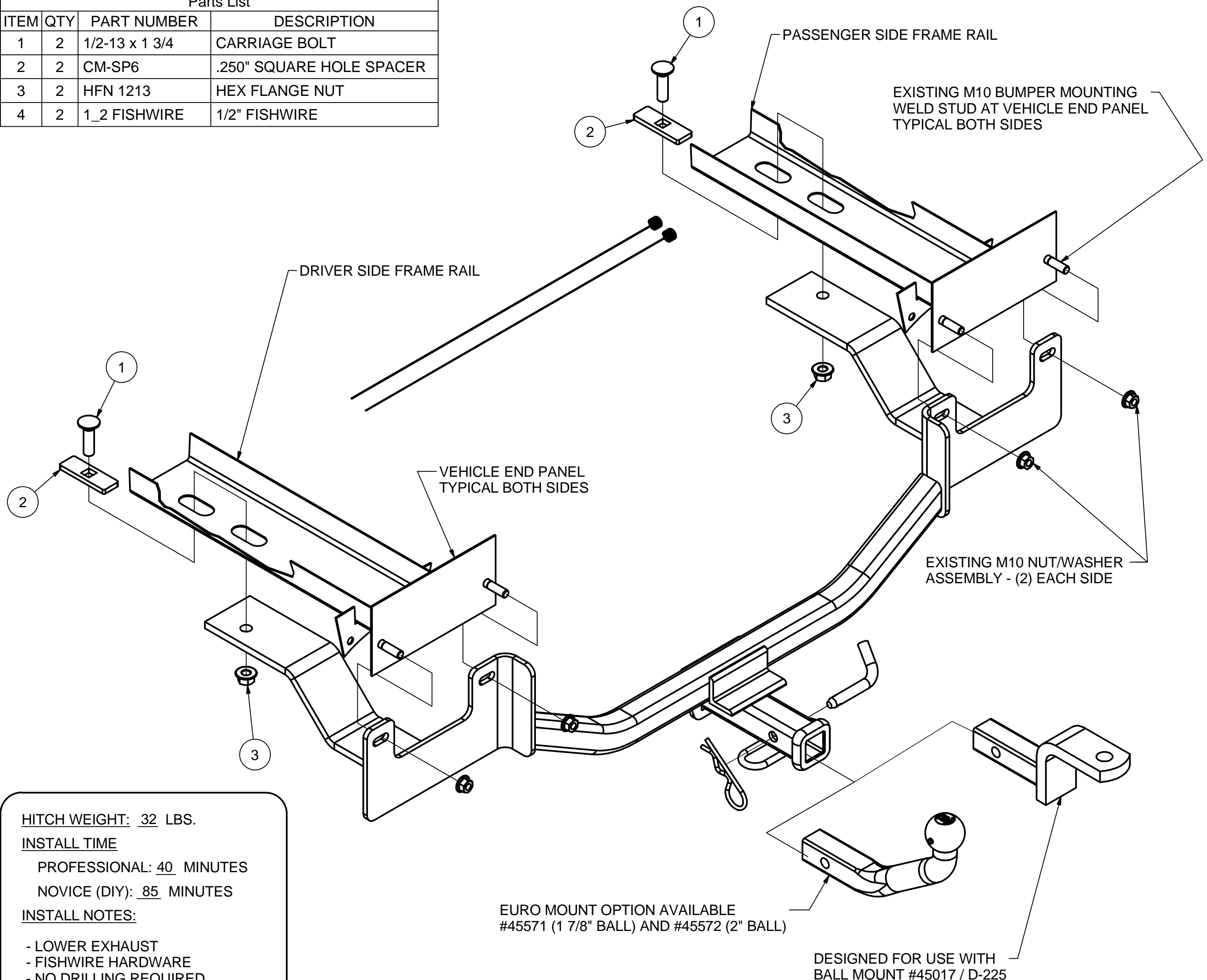
6. Attach 1/2-13 flanged hex nuts to carriage bolts at hitch side arms. Torque all M10 fasteners to 50 ft-lbs. Torque all 1/2" fasteners to 75 ft-lbs.

7. Reattach exhaust hanger bracket by reinstalling bolts.
