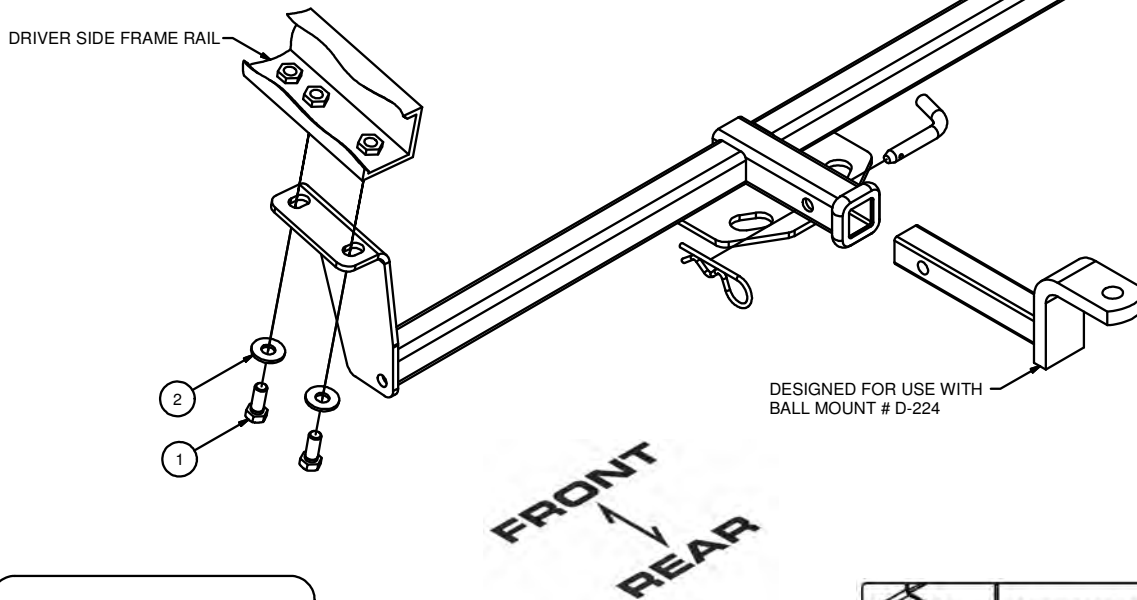
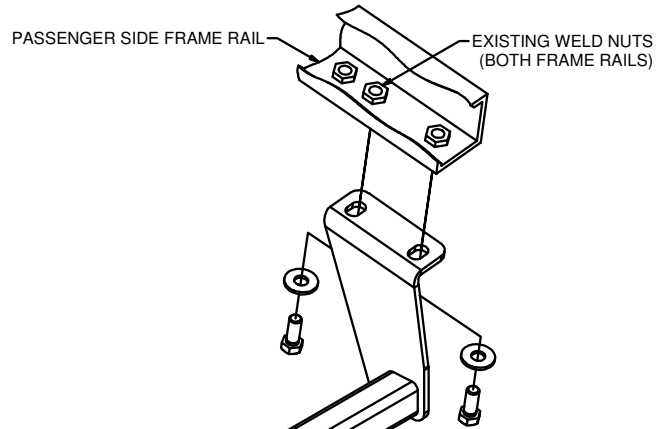

WELDNUT CLEANING



To remove debris from weldnuts in frame, spray lubricant or compressed air into hole. For heavy debris, use a small wire brush. (Be careful not to damage threads).

INSTALLATION STEPS

1. Remove the tow hooks (if equipped), return to customer.
2. Raise the hitch into position, aligning the slots in the side plates with the existing weld nuts in the frame rails.
3. Install hex bolts and conical toothed washers as shown.
4. Torque all 12mm hardware to 86 ft-lbs.

PERIODICALLY CHECK THIS RECEIVER HITCH TO ENSURE THAT ALL FASTENERS ARE TIGHT AND THAT ALL STRUCTURAL COMPONENTS ARE SOUND.
