INSTALLATION STEPS

1. Fasten the hitch with (1) 12mm bolt to the center of the rear bumper without removing the rubber bumper strip. First, locate the existing hole at the center of the metal part of the rear bumper. This hole may be located by looking inside the bumper. Make a 3/4" hole in the rubber strip centered on the existing hole.

NOTE: On early models, a permanent 12mm nut is provided in place of the existing hole. Make matching 3/4" hole in the rubber as before and discard the 12mm nut and flat washer provided with the hitch. Use the 7/16" lock washer under the head of the 12mm bolt.

- 2. Clear the trunk and lift the floor covering in the trunk. Using the hitch as a template, drill the vehicle floor (4) places for 3/8" hardware.
- 3. Install fasteners as shown, making sure fender washers are placed inside the vehicle, opposite the hitch.
- 4. Torque all 3/8" fasteners to 45 lb-ft, and 12mm fastener to 79 lb-ft.
- 5. Use silicone sealant to seal hardware installed through trunk floor.
- 6. Reinstall contents removed in Step 2.
