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



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INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. Lower three (3) exhaust hangers and remove heat shield.
- 2. Enlarge forward most hole on passenger side frame rail (1 1/8") for fishwire access. Fishwire carriage bolt and spacer into existing hole on the passenger side as shown.
- 3. Lift the passenger side of the hitch into position; centered and square on the car. Loosely attach the passenger side of the hitch. Using the hitch as a template, mark and drill the vehicle's frame rail two (2) places for fasteners as shown.
- 4. Hold the supplied driver side plate to the frame. Raise the driver side of the hitch into positon and loosley fasten to driver side plate. Using the plate as a template; mark and drill two (2) holes in the frame rail. Lower the hitch assembly.
- 5. Push the exhaust towards the center of the vehcile to drill driver side mounting holes and access hole (1 1/8") as shown. Fishwire all remaining carriage bolts and spacers into position, making sure the short spacer is installed in the rear-most hole on passenger side.
- 6. Trim the heat shield to provide clearance for driver side plate and refit it onto the vehicle.
- 7. Raise driver side plate into position and secure using forward most hole first. (**Note**: exhaust hanger bracket must be above plate before installing)
- 8. Reinstall passenger side of hitch and torque both parts together. Torque all 1/2" fasteners to 110 lb-ft.

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
