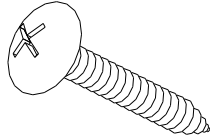

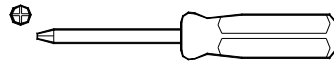

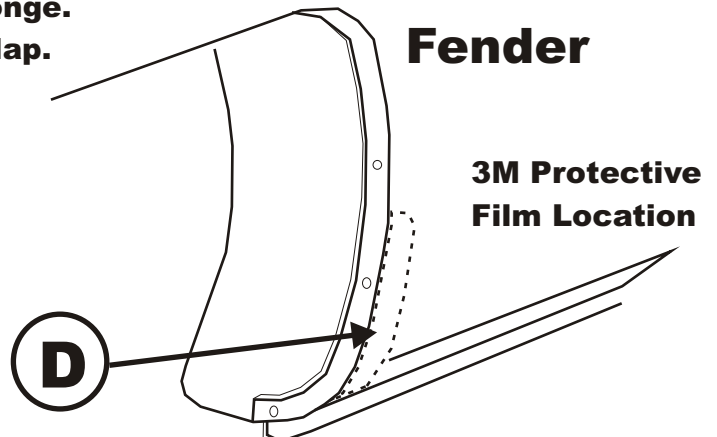

3M Protective Film Installation:

Dee Zee mudflaps are designed to fit snugly into the wheel well. To protect your vehicle, Dee Zee has included a 3M protective film.

- 1) Hold the mudflap up to wheel well to determine 3M protective film placement.
- 2) Thoroughly clean the area where the film is to be installed using 3M brand adhesive cleaner or other petroleum distillate based cleaner.
- 3) Cut the film to the proper shape for your application.
- 4) Mix a solution of water and dishwasher detergent into a spray bottle.
- 5) Remove film from the protective liner and spray with the water solution.
- 6) Apply the film to the fender, adhesive side down and spray total area with water solution.
- 7) Remove any air bubbles in film using a wet sponge.
- 8) Let film dry completely before installing mud flap.

Mudflap Installation:

1) Place the mudflap up to the wheel well and use the holes in the mudflap as a guide to center punch and mark the mounting holes on the fender well. (Note: There are no holes in the lower part of the attachment flange of the Mudflap. This will have to be drilled.)

2) Using a 1/8" Drill bit and drill, drill a hole in the three locations

3) Now secure the mudflap to the wheel well using the #8 x 3/4" phillips head screws (B) and a 1/4" Flat Washer (C). Tighten into place using a short phillips head screwdriver.

(Note: The screws have a wax coating that when installed, will seal the holes in the vehicle.)
