Dodge Transmission Drop Bracket for 2003 and Newer Dodge 2500/3500 **4WD with Pro Comp** Lift Kits

INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Position your vehicle on a smooth, flat, hard surface (i.e. concrete or asphalt). Block the rear tires and set the emergency brake.
- 2. Carefully place a jack under the transmission bracket and raise it up to relieve the weight on the crossmember and the supports.
- 3. Remove the **OE** bolts that secure the bracket between the transmission and the rubber crossmember transmission mount.

Note the orientation of the transmission bracket before removal.

4. Install the transmission drop bracket (90-5140 or 90-5143 or 90-5146 or 90-5149 or 90-5152 depending on application) to the transmission using the previously removed **OE** bolts. Torque the bolts to 50 ft./lbs.

5. Carefully lower the jack until the transmission drop bracket is resting in place on the transmission rubber mount. Secure using the previously removed **OE** bolts and the supplied 10mm nuts and washers. Torque the bolts to 50 ft./lbs.

NOTE: You may have to loosen the rubber transmission mount bolts for proper alignment.

- ⇒ After 100 miles recheck for proper torque on all newly installed hardware.
- ⇒ Recheck all hardware for tightness after off road use.
