Thank you for purchasing one of our fine quality products. Your seat cover is engineered from high quality materials and designed with precision to give you a long-lasting, well-adjusted fit.

INSTRUCTIONS:

BACKREST COVERS:

- 1) Remove center seat belt strap from the base (see note below)
- 2) Remove headrests (see note below)
- 3) Slip cover over backrest. Holding cushion up in 3/4 position allows for better access
- 4) With cushion down, feed straps behind the seat
- 5) Smooth cover tightly from top to bottom
- 6) Locate straps and secure to buckles on seat cover
- 7) Tuck bottom of cover through crevice under backrest and tighten straps and buckles
- 8) Locate bottom right flap through crevice and hold at back of seat.
- 9) With other hand bring the side flap around and attach (see note below)
- 10) Repeat on other side
- 11) Adjust all straps, buckles and velcro to ensure a snug fit
- 12) Re-install headrests (see note below)

B) CUSHION COVERS:

- 1) Center cover on the seat. Cover has allowance for seat belt buckle
- 2) Tuck back flap through crevice
- 3) Lift seat and pass the front strap under seat and buckle
- 4) Pass side straps around the back and buckle

- 5) Adjust straps and buckles to equalize tension and ensure a snug fit
- 6) Replace center seat belt strap on base

NOTES:

1) SELF-LOCKING SUPER-GRIP® BUCKLE:



2) HEAD REST REMOVAL:

- A) Insert paper clip into holes at base to release - Lift off
- B) Push in side release buttons
 - Lift off



A) Insert paper clip into slot at base to release and lift



3) BOTTOM FLAP INSTALLATION



4) RE-INSTALLATION OF HEADRESTS

- A) Ensure pre-cut holes in seat cover align with holes in headrest base.
- B) Replace headrests
