A) BACKREST COVERS - BUCKETS / "40" PORTIONS:

1) Remove head rest (see note below)

- 2) Move seat to most forward position
- 3) Slip cover over backrest and pull down firmly

B) CUSHION COVERS - BUCKETS / "40" PORTIONS:

- 1) Center cover on the seat
- 2) Pass straps through crevice, under seat and buckle to front
- 3) Pass side straps through the opening between the molded plastic and the seat

C) BACKREST COVER - "20" PORTION (TR49-23, OE39-23, SP89-23, TR49-24, OE39-24, SP89-24) :

- 1) Open armrest / storage compartment
- 2) Center cover under armrest
