

FOR CHOKE DELAY KIT P/N 45-267 (85R6161)

- 1. Remove the ground wire from the choke cap. The positive lead should not have to be disconnected for this installation.
- 2. Remove the three choke cap assembly (See Fig. 1).
- 3. Remove the choke gasket, and install the piece of shrink tubing over the choke tang (See NOTE in line #4 and Fig. 2).



- 4. Using a soldering gun, heat the choke tang lever, until the shrink tubing is drawn tight against the tang (See Fig. 3). NOTE: For those choke units that contain a double tang, an additional piece of heat shrink tubing of a larger diameter is supplied. Use the correct tubing size for each tang.
- 5. Being careful to align the tang through the choke cap, carefully reinstall the choke cap and gasket assembly. Set the choke cap at index.
- 6. Connect the thermister wire to the (-) ground lead on the choke cap. Bolt the thermister to the intake manifold (See Fig. 4).
- 7. Before starting the engine, check for binding or sticking linkage.
