

## 41855 - Vehicle Wiring Installation Instructions Toyota 4-Runner 2010 Adapter Harness

- 1. Locate the (2) vehicle wiring harness plugs at the rear of vehicle above the factory 7- Way RV socket assembly. This connector harness will have the same connector ends as the Hopkins<sup>®</sup> Adapter Harness.
- 2. Disconnect the vehicle wiring harness plugs (2). Connectors can be disconnected by pressing or lifting on a locking tab and pulling apart.
- 3. Remove the factory adapter harness from the factory 7-way socket by pressing or lifting on a locking tab to disconnect it.
- 4. Note: If you wish to replace the existing factory 7-way socket connector purchase the Hopkins Multi-Tow #40955 (sold separately).
- 5. Insert the Adapter Harness into the rear of the existing factory 7-way making sure the connector is fully inserted and locked.
- 6. Route the wire harness to the (2) vehicle plugs. Connect the plugs and make sure the connectors are fully inserted and locked.
- 7. Plug trailer connector into the factory 7-way receptacle and test all functions with the engine running to ensure proper operation.

## TIPS:

Grease should be applied to the wiring terminals on a regular basis to help prevent corrosion.

A heavy duty flasher may be required to eliminate rapid flashing.

Always unplug boat trailer connector before backing trailer into the water.
