

Installation Instructions



Sometimes the billet products get bent in the shipping process. You may need to hand bend them to attain the desired shape.


Installation Steps Illustrations may vary upon application

Open the hood and remove all seven (7) of the stock black plastic rivets on the radiator cover by prying up the center of the rivet with a flat head screwdriver. Keep the rivets to reinstall the grille shell later.




turn to loosen the center of the grille shell.


To remove the side clips, pull the center bar out just enough to slide a flat head screwdriver between the grille shell and the fender. Be extremely careful in between the grille and the fender. Touching the side clip, very carefully turn the handle of the screwdriver to pull out the side clip.




Pull the stock grille shell towards you to remove from the vehicle. Place the stock grille shell face down. Make sure to work on a flat, non-abrasive surface, blanket, or towel to prevent scratching.



Bottom Grille Installation


For this step, you will need: Drill with 1/8" Drill Bit, Rivet Gun, 4 - 1/8" x 1/2" Pop Rivets, and the Bottom Billet Grille Insert the bottom Billet Grille from the front into the bottom stock grille shell opening. Make sure that the grille is centered and fits tightly against the grille shell. Be careful not to scratch the grille shell as you are putting it in. Once the grille is in place, locate the tabs on each end. Drill through the tabs and grille shell using a 1/8" drill bit to make a rivet hole. Rivet the tab and shell together. Drill and rivet all remaining tabs.

Top Grille Installation


For this step, you will need: Drill with 1/8" Drill Bit, Rivet Gun, 2 - 1/8" x 1/2" Pop Rivets, 2 - 3/8" Hex Head Screws, flat head screwdriver, and the Top Billet Grille. Insert the top Billet Grille from the front into the top stock grille shell opening. Drill and rivet the 2 top tabs. Once the 2 top tabs are secure, drill pilot holes for the Hex Head Screws. Note: Before you drill the pilot hole, make sure the grille fits tightly against the grille shell. Line up the outer dowels with the pilot holes and screw the Hex Head Screws into the dowels.

Reinstall the stock shell with your new Billet Grille onto the vehicle. Place the grille shell back on the front of the vehicle and line up the side clips and clip back in place. Tighten the 4 plastic screws. Screw the center bolt back into place. Put the radiator cover back in place and pop in the 7 stock black plastic rivets. Make sure everything is secure and close the hood. Enjoy your award-winning product that you have just installed!



Care and Cleaning

To keep your billet inserts looking their best, we recommend using only mild soap and water and a soft cotton cloth to wash and dry it. Use of rough cleaning agents or cloths may scratch or dull your billet inserts.

Should your billet inserts become scratched or dull, we recommend TRENZ® Metal Polish to bring back the mirror finish. There are three grades of TRENZ® Metal Polish (Coarse, Medium and Fine) that will help you keep your billet inserts looking brand new. Select the TRENZ® Metal Polishes best for your needs:

- 1. Course (Red) Polish For severe scratches and pitted problems.
- 2. Medium (Green) Polish For light scratches and dulling problems.
- 3. Fine (White) Polish To bring back the mirror finish.

TRENZ® Metal Polish can be used on all metal products, including aluminum, stainless steel, brass and copper.
