To keep your billet grille looking their best, we recommend using only mild soap and water and a soft cotton cloth to wash and dry it. Use of rough cleaning agents or cloths may scratch or dull your billet grille.

Should your billet grille become scratched or dull, we recommend TRENZ® Metal Polish to bring back the mirror finish. There are three grades of TRENZ® Metal Polish (Coarse, Medium and Fine) that will help you keep your billet grille looking brand new. Select the TRENZ® Metal Polishes best for your needs:

- 1. Course (Red) Polish For severe scratches and pitted problems.
- 2. Medium (Green) Polish For light scratches and dulling problems.
- 3. Fine (White) Polish To bring back the mirror finish.

Shipping Note

Sometimes the billet products get bent in the shipping process. You may need to hand bend them to attain the desired shape.

Installation Steps


Grille Shell Removal:

Remove the marker lights. Behind the marker lights there are four clips, two on each side. Use a flat head screwdriver to pry them loose. Release the four clips on the top of the grille shell. Gently pull the top of the grille shell away from the vehicle. Reach down and release the bottom three clips and remove the grille shell from the vehicle.

Use a die grinder to cut away the inner plastic webbing. *Note: Leave the inner plastic lip!*

Use an angle grinder to sand down any of the remaining webbing to leave a smooth finish. Be careful not to scratch the grille shell.



Top Grille Installation:


From the front, insert the top billet grille into the grille shell so that the billet grille sits inside the inner lip of the grille shell. Make sure the billet grille is centered and flush with the grille shell.

Secure the bottom four mounting tabs with four small slider tabs and four hair pin clips as shown below.



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
Drill three 1/8" holes through the grille shell, using the top mounting tab holes as guides. Rivet the billet grille mounting tabs to the grille shell.



Bottom Grille Installation:

Insert the bottom billet grille into the stock grille shell so that the billet grille sits inside the inner lip of the grille shell. Make sure the billet grille is centered and flush with the grille shell.

Use four small slider tabs and hair pin clips to secure the top of the billet grille. Use the four large slider tabs and hair pin clips to secure the bottom of the billet grille. Make sure everything is secure and reinstall the grille shell.



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
