



## Shipping Note

Sometimes the billet products get bent in the shipping process. You may need to hand bend them to attain the desired shape.

## Care and Cleaning

To keep your billet grille looking their best, we recommend using only mild soap and water and a soft cotton cloth to wash and dry it. Use of rough cleaning agents or cloths may scratch or dull your billet grille.

Should your billet grille become scratched or dull, we recommend Lund® Metal Polish to bring back the mirror finish. There are three grades of Lund® Metal Polish (Coarse, Medium and Fine) that will help you keep your billet grille looking brand new. Select the Lund® Metal Polishes best for your needs:

1. Course (Red) Polish – For severe scratches and pitted problems.
2. Medium (Green) Polish – For light scratches and dulling problems.
3. Fine (White) Polish – To bring back the mirror finish.

Lund® Metal Polish can be used on all metal products, including aluminum, stainless steel, brass and copper. 

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

## Installation Steps Illustrations may vary upon application

Open the hood and remove the three black plastic rivets that secure the top of the grille shell. Save these for later.






Once the plastic rivets are out and the top is free, look behind the grille and locate the two push retainers that secure the tips of the center chrome bar. Use a flat head screwdriver to carefully pry off the push retainers.





Insert the bottom of the new Billet Grille into the vehicle first. Once the bottom tabs are in place, lift up on the mounting holes and push the Billet Grille in further so that the tab slides under the mounting holes.





Once the bottom of the Billet Grille is in place, secure the top of it by attaching it with the three plastic rivets that were removed in step one.
