Care and Cleaning

To keep your billet grille looking their best, we recommend using only mild soap and water and a soft cotton cloth to wash and dry it. Use of rough cleaning agents or cloths may scratch or dull your billet grille.

Should your billet grille become scratched or dull, we recommend TRENZ® Metal Polish to bring back the mirror finish. There are three grades of TRENZ® Metal Polish (Coarse, Medium and Fine) that will help you keep your billet grille looking brand new. Select the TRENZ® Metal Polishes best for your needs:

1. Course (Red) Polish – For severe scratches and pitted problems.

- 2. Medium (Green) Polish For light scratches and dulling problems.
- 3. Fine (White) Polish To bring back the mirror finish.

TRENZ® Metal Polish can be used on all metal products, including aluminum, stainless steel, brass and copper. 


Open the hood. Remove the top pin securing the turn signal light to the radiator support. Remove the turn signal light.




Use a flat head screwdriver to unsnap each clip that holds the stock grille shell to the vehicle. Each arrow indicates approximate location of each clip.




Use a die grinder to cut away the inner mesh. Note: Be sure to leave the inner lip!



Insert the billet grille into the front of the bumper shell. The billet grille mounting studs will stick out past the stock mesh. Place a mounting bracket over each mounting stud and secure with the provided hardware.



Drill a 1/8" hole through the top black plastic grille shell and two mounting tabs on the top billet grille. Rivet into place.



Reinstall the stock grille shell back into the truck and make sure everything is secure.
