- 1. Course (Red) Polish For severe scratches and pitted problems.
- 2. Medium (Green) Polish For light scratches and dulling problems.
- 3. Fine (White) Polish To bring back the mirror finish.





Sometimes the billet products get bent in the shipping process. You may need to hand bend them to attain the desired shape.


Caution

Grille covers may reduce airflow which may result in higher operating temperatures. Monitor your vehicle's operating temperature to ensure proper operating conditions.


Installation Steps

Remove the bolts holding the bottom of the bumper to the skidplate. Save bolts for reinstallation.

Insert the center bumper grille into the center bumper opening. Make sure that the billet grille is centered and that the set screws fit between the mesh.




Reach in and up to the back of the center grille through the space between the skid plate and the front end to slide washers over the set screws use the kep nuts to secure in place. Caution: Do not over-tighten kep nuts!




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Place the side bumper grille over the mesh and make sure that the billet grille is centered. Mark the holes were the setscrew touch the mesh. Then drill out the holes marked with a 1/4" drill bit.



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Place the left side bumper grille into the grille opening making sure to line up the set screws with the holes drilled. Reach in and up to the back of the side grille, through the space between the skid plate and the front end to slide washers over the set screws. Use the kep nuts to secure grille in place. Caution: do not over-tighten kep nuts! Repeat steps 4-5 for the right side bumper grille.



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
