- 3/8" X 2" BOLT(2PCS)
- 3/8" WASHER (4PCS)

MBPPING.

2004-2008 Chev Colorado, GMC Canyon

Removal of stock system:

- 1. Apply a penetrating lubricant liberally to all exhaust fasteners, hangers and rubber insulators.
- 2. Cut the exhaust in front of the muffler so that it can be removed from the vehicle. **Refer to Figure 1**.
- 3. Remove the nuts from the studs holding the front flange together and disconnect exhaust system. **Refer to Figure 2**.
- 4. Remove the hangers from the rubber insulators. Remove the exhaust from the vehicle. **Refer to Figure 3**.

Installation of MBRP Inc. Performance Exhaust:

- 1. Install the **Extension Pipe** to the existing flange using the fasteners provided. **Refer to Figure 4**.
- 2. Slide a 2 ½" Clamp over the Extension Pipe and install Muffler onto the Extension Pipe. Attach the Muffler to the existing rubber insulator. Refer to Figure 5.
- 3. Slide a **2** ½" **Clamp** over the outlet side of the **Muffler**. Position the **Exhaust tip** using the existing rubber insulator and loosely attach it to the **Muffler**.
- 7. Align the exhaust as required. Starting at the front of the exhaust, tighten all clamps and connections.
- 9. Check along the whole length of the exhaust system to ensure that there is adequate clearance fuel and brake lines or any wiring. If any interference is detected relocate or adjust.
