SHOP SUPPLIES:



SPRAY LUBRICANT

To ease removal of existing exhaust components (especially on older vehicles) spray penetrating lubricant on all fasteners and hangers/insulators that will be loosened or removed and let soak before disassembly.

1. [16] HEADER BOLTS 2 [2] MANIFOLD GASKET

ATTENTION: Always install any supplied band or U-bolt clamps to the proper torque specifications of 40-45 ft-lbs for band clamps and 30-35 ft-lbs for U-bolt clamps. Over tightening will result in the clamp breaking and will NOT be warranted by MagnaFlow.

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INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS



Step 1. Before removing the OEM manifold system, first disconnect the battery using a 10mm socket. Remove the engine covers by gently pulling to disengage it from the rubber grommets.



Step 2. Disconnect both O2 sensors from the OEM manifolds.



Step 3. Remove all spark plug wires from the coils and the plugs, and then set aside. On the passenger side unbolt the coil pack bracket using a 10mm socket and gently flip the assembly towards the upper part of the motor.



Step 4. On the passenger side release the pressure on the drive belt tensioner with a 15mm socket and remove the serpentine belt.




Step 5. Using a 15mm socket unbolt the alternator and remove. After alternator has been removed repeat passenger side process to remove the coil pack bracket.



Step 6. Using a 15mm socket remove the dipstick assembly.

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Step 7. Using a 15mm socket unbolt both catalytic converters from the OEM manifolds.




Step 8. Unbolt and remove both driver and passenger side manifolds with a 10mm socket. Remove the O2 sensor from the manifolds using a 7/8" wrench.



Step 9. Reinstall the O2 sensors on your new header assemblies. With the supplied gaskets and header bolts install your header assemblies with a 10mm socket to the manufacturers torque specifications.



Step 10. On the passenger side with your new header installed, you will notice a bracket located on one of the tubes. You will need to reinstall the dipstick assembly to that bracket using the OEM bolt and nut provided with a 17mm socket. Reinstall both coil pack brackets and sparkplug wires to the coil pack and plugs. Reconnect both O2 sensors. Next reinstall the alternator and serpentine belt. Then reconnect the motor covers.



Step 11. Align the OEM converters up to the new headers and attach using the OEM nuts and bolts. Tighten the bolts to the manufacturers torque specifications. After all OEM parts have been reinstalled reconnect the battery.
