INSTALLATION

- 1. Mount the Switch in a position that is within easy reach of the driver.
- 2. Install the wiring harness to the Pro Mag Electronic Unit and route the harness to the Switch. Be sure the wires are routed away from sharp edges and engine heat sources. If it is necessary to cut the wires to length, shorten the outer sleeve of the harness two inches shorter than the wires.
- 3. Crimp the eye connectors to the stripped harness wires and connect them to the Switch using the supplied screws. It does not matter which terminal each wire is connected to. Make sure the connectors are fastened securely.
- 4. Depending on the position of the Switch, choose the correct On/Off label for your needs. The key notch on the Switch should match the notch on the label to read properly.




Figure 1 Wiring the Pro Mag Kill Switch.
