







With both brackets secured, key the flared end of the tracks onto the housing stems (stem goes on back side of track) being sure to carefully feed the handle into the throat of the track, as shown in **diagram 7**.

Place the tracks onto the bed rails so that the track brackets sit upon the bed brackets as shown in **diagram 8**. Secure the track brackets to the bed brackets using the 1/4" lock washers and 1/4-28 X 1" socket head screws.




### Step three: Installing the tailgate extrusion (Illustration Shown is Ford Supercrew)



The tailgate extrusion is the most critical part of the installation process and must be done correctly for the lock mechanism to work properly. The first step is to slip the flange of the tailgate extrusion under the edge of the plastic tallgate panel (unique to this vehicle). Next, center the extrusion on the tailgate, and while holding it perpendicular fasten the center screw as shown in **diagram 11**. Again being sure to hold the extrusion perpendicular and formed down against the tailgate, fasten each end before securing the remaining fasteners as shown in diagram 12. This process is also thoroughly described on page 6, Standard Installation Guide.

With the tailgate centered and secured, loosen the 1/4 - 28 socket head screws shown in **diagram 8** and shift the tracks inward (toward center) so that the biased face of the track caps contact the biased face of the tailgate extrusion end caps as shown in **diagram 13**. Re-tighten the tracks in this location.





#### Step Four: Securing the cargo shield and housing lid. (Illustration shown is Ford Supercrew)

With the tracks in place, you can now install the cargo shield as shown in **diagram 14**. Notice that the elongated holes are on the bottom, and the rubber washers go on the inside of the shield. The easiest way to install the cargo shield is to place the truss head bolts through the holes in the shield and press or thread the rubber washers onto the threads of the bolts as shown on

page 10. Standard Installation Guide. Next, pull the cover out of the housing and latch it at or near the tailgate (latches will fire automatically if lock lever is in the 7 o'clock position). Do not allow the cover to retract yet, as the vinyl could be damaged. Now, remove the cardboard packing which is in the housing. Next, place the housing Ild onto the housing flanges and align the flange holes as shown in diagrams 15 and 16. Use the 1/4-20 X 5/8° black counter sunk screws to secure the lid, but do not use a screw gun and do not overtighten, as the lid must occassionally be removed to inspect for debris.



Drill 1/2" hole in bed to provide drain tube exit point. Drain tubes connect to fittings at each end of the housing. For additional information, refer to page 4, Standard Installation Guide.

Your cover is now operational and if you have followed the instructions carefully, it will function smoothly and will latch effortlessly. We recommend that you use the 303 vinyl protectant which was provided to remove finger prints and give the cover an initial cleaning. 303 should also be applied to the top and bottom track runners. Regular application of 303 will keep your Roll-N-Lock cover looking like new. Enjoy your Roll-N-Lock®

(14) #8 X 3/4\* drill point button head screw for attachment of mounting flange to bed rall and taligate extrusion to taligate



(2) #12 X 1/2" self tapping pan head screw for attachment of track to reel support stem



(2) 1/4" lock washer for attachment of track bracket to bed bracket



(2) 1/4 - 28 X 1\* socket head screw for attachment of track bracket to bed bracket



(2) 6mm X 30 mm pan head phillps head screws for attachment of bed bracket



(4) 1/4 - 20 X 5/8" countersunk self tapping screw For attachment of lid to housing flange



(4) Rubber washers for cargo shield assembly



(1) Pull strap holder pad for securement of pull strap to rear of bed



(2) Drainage tubes for drainage of Housing, at left and right corners



(2) 1/4" Washers for attachment of bed bracket



(1) 303 Vinyl protectant To clean and preserve vinyl (Give to customers)



(1) 3/16" Hex key for tightening of track bracket to bed bracket



(2) Rectangular spacer / washer for attachment of bed bracket
