## INSTALLATION INSTRUCTIONS

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1. Remove factory rear a-arm guards, if applicable.

2. Place brackets( A4 and A6) on top of lower A-arm. See Figure 1.

Place A-arm guard (A2) into position on A-arm. See Figure 2.

Install M6 Screws (B3) through guard and brackets. Fasten with washer (B1) and lock nuts (B2). See Figure 3.

4. Align guard as needed. Tighten all fasteners to torque specification listed above.

5. Repeat steps one through four for installing guard (A1) on other A-Arm.
