




ANTI-SEIZE LUBRICANT MUST BE USED ON ALL STAINLESS STEEL FASTENERS TO PREVENT THREAD DAMAGE AND GALLING



PROCEDURE

- 1. Remove contents from box, verify if all parts listed are present and free from damage. Carefully read and understand all instructions before attempting installation.
 - Failure to identify damage before installation could lead to a rejection of any claim.
- 2. Open the hood, remove the plastic radiator cover by pulling up all of the factory plastic rivets. Figure 1
- 3. Once the plastic cover has been set aside, remove the grille shell by releasing the retaining pinch clips.
- 4. Locate the two factory bumper bolts on each side of the bumper and remove them. Figure 2







- 5. Take the light bar and attach it using the previously removed factory hardware. **Figure 3**
- 6. Fully tighten all hardware at this time. Torque all M10 bolts to 30-35 ft lbs and M14 to 90-95 ft lbs Re-install grille shell and radiator cover at this time





CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- REGULAR WAXING IS RECOMMENDED. DO NOT USE ANY TYPE OF POLISH OR WAX THAT MAY CONTAIN ABRASIVES.
- STAINLESS STEEL PRODUCTS CAN BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER. STAINLESS STEEL POLISH SHOULD BE USED TO POLISH SMALL SCRATCHES.
- GLOSS BLACK FINISHES SHOULD BE CLEANED WITH MILD SOAP AND WATER.
