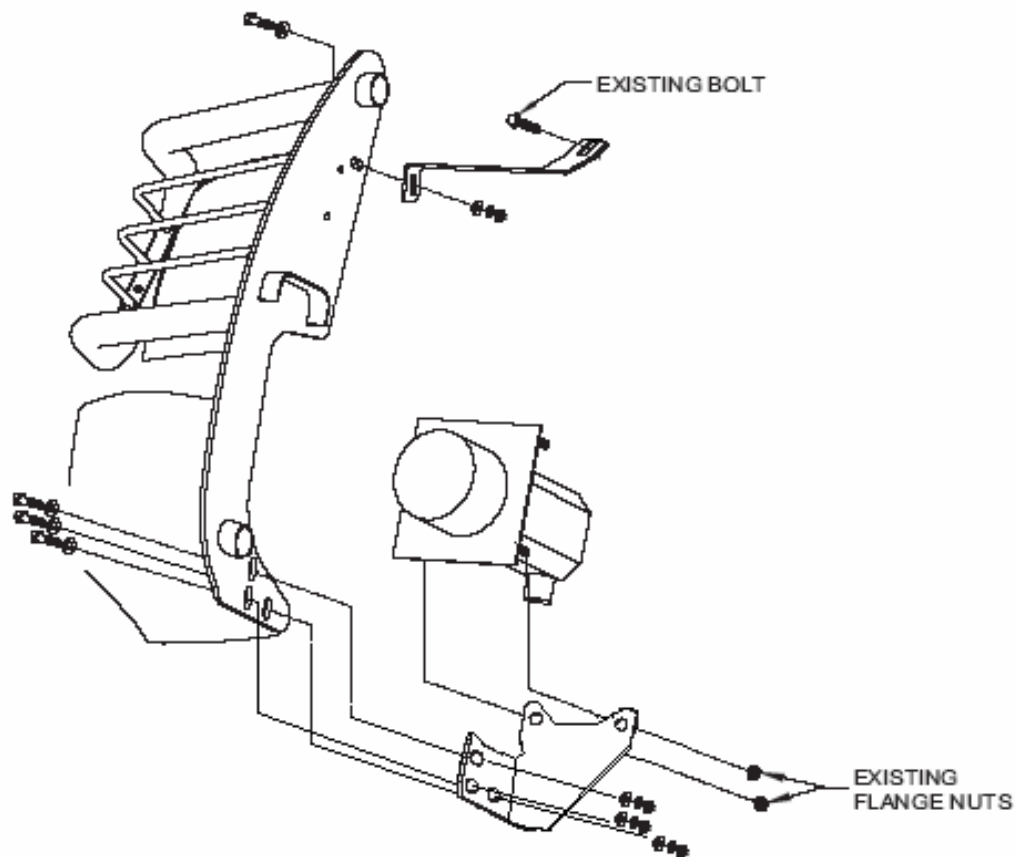

2	Frame Mount Brackets
2	Top Brace
2	M10*35 Button Head Bolt, Stainless Steel
4	M10 Flat Washer, Stainless Steel
2	M10 Lock Washer, Stainless Steel
2	M10 Hex Nut, Stainless Steel
6	M12*40 Hex Head Bolt, Stainless Steel
12	M12 Flat Washer, Stainless Steel
6	M12 Lock Washer, Stainless Steel
6	M12 Hex Nut, Stainless Steel

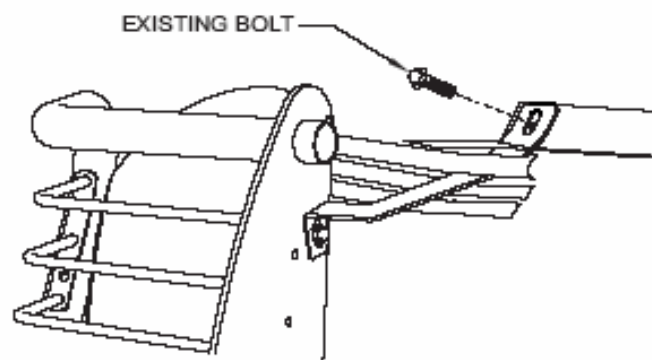
Note: Westin Automotive advises the installer to use a thread lubricant on all of the stainless steel fasteners.

PROCEDURE

1. Remove contents from box and verify all parts are present. Read instructions completely before beginning.
2. Start with passenger side frame bracket. Remove the 2 lower nuts holding the bumper frame to the main frame and then attach frame brackets using the existing flange nuts.
3. Repeat for driver-side Frame Mount Bracket.
4. Open hood and support **without using the prop rod**, remove the radiator shroud by removing 12 plastic push type retainers, save the retainers for re-installation. Attach the Top Brace as shown. Leave loose.
5. Repeat above for driver side.
6. Line up the 3 holes on the lower portion of the Grille Guard with the 3 holes of the Frame Mount Brackets and attach using (3) M12*40 hex bolts, (6) M12 flat washers, and (3) M12 hex lock nuts for each side. Hand tighten.
7. Proceed to attach top support brackets to the outer edge of grille guard uprights using the stainless steel M10 x 35 button head bolts, M10 flat washers, M10 lock washers, and M10 hex nuts.
8. Align Grille Guard assembly with front of the vehicle and tighten all fasteners.
