- 1) Thoroughly clean front hood area. Open hood.
- 2) Remove gasket above headlights by removing the factory plugs. (Your new bugshield eliminates the need for the gasket).
- 3) Place the nylon insert "locking plugs" into the two OUTSIDE holes.

## DO NOT PUSH IN THE LOCKING DEVICE YET

- 4) Mark the position of the inside holes. Remove the outside "plugs" and remove shield from vehicle.
- 5) With a 1/8" drill bit, carefully drill the two outside holes. IMPORTANT: Take care not to drill through or damage the top of the hood.
- 6) Place shield back on vehicle and re-insert the two outside "plugs".
- 7) Screw in (by hand) the screws with the supplied washers .

## DO NOT OVER TIGHTEN SCREW OR YOU WILL VOID THE WARRANTY.

- 8) Push in the locking device on the two outside "plugs".
- 9) Close hood and tell all your friends about your FANTASTIC new shield from WADE.

Cleaning Instructions: Wash with warm water and a mild soap solution using a soft, clean cloth or sponge. Use of cleaners not approved for acrylic, or use of improper solvents could result in permanent damage which will not be covered by the warranty.
