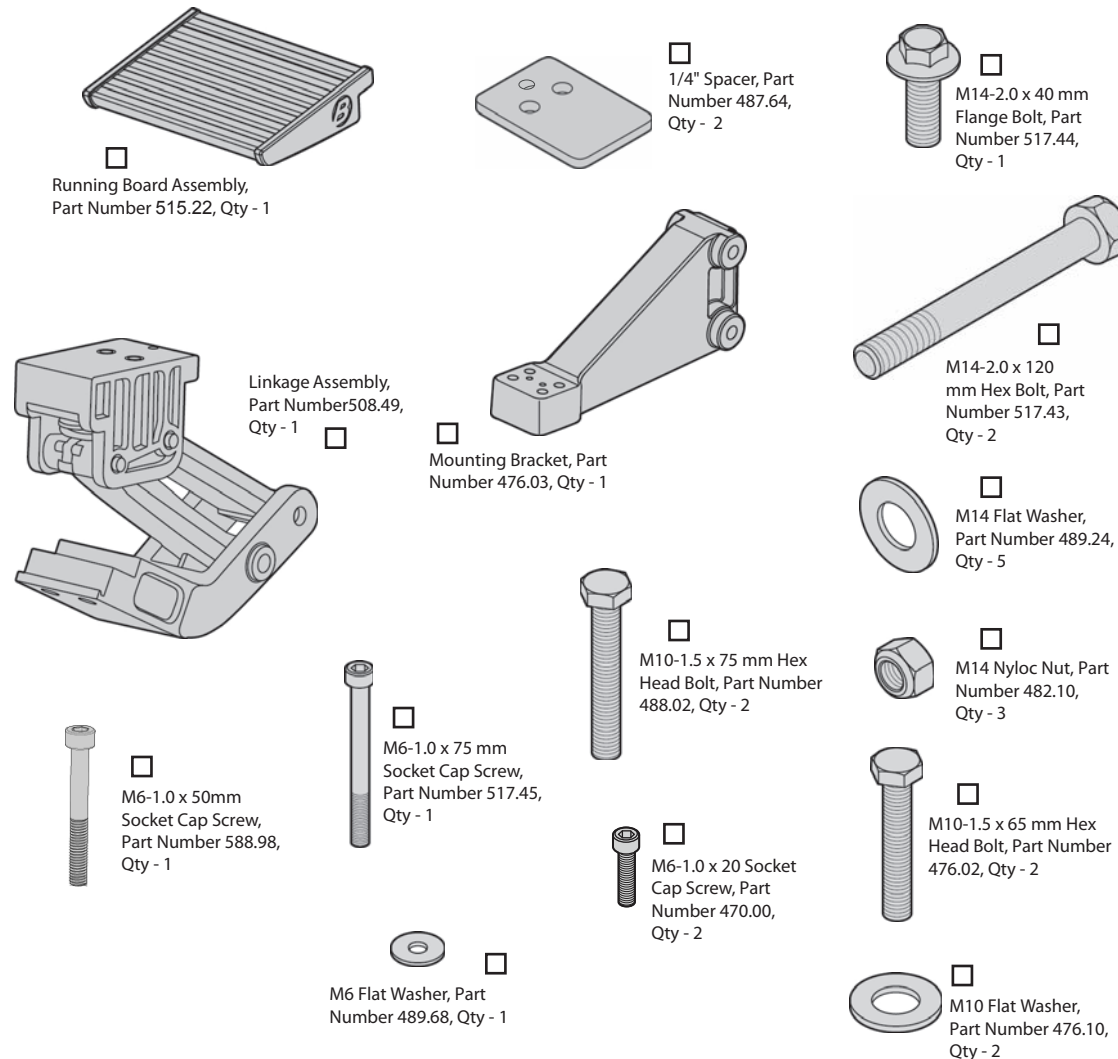

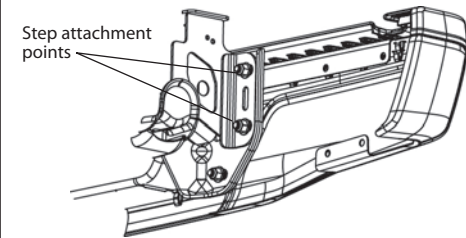
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Parts List and Hardware Identification



1 Locate Rear Bumper Attachment

Locate the rear bumper attachment points.

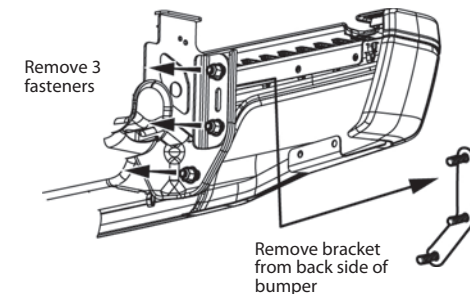


2 Remove Bumper Bracket

Remove the three (3) bumper fasteners. Then remove the bracket from the back of the bumper.

NOTE If vehicle does not have factory hitch, the factory bracket will only have two (2) studs.

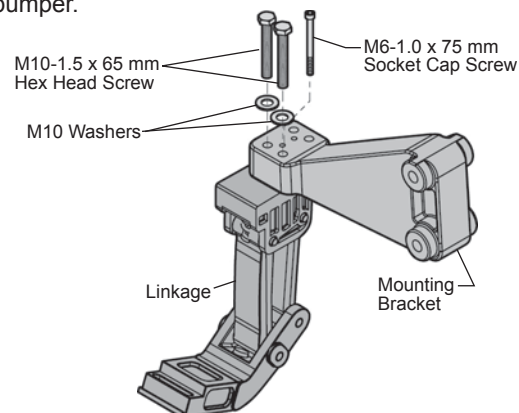
NOTE Studs in bracket are held in place by a spring fastener. To remove, lightly tap the end of the bracket studs to loosen the spring washer, then remove bracket.



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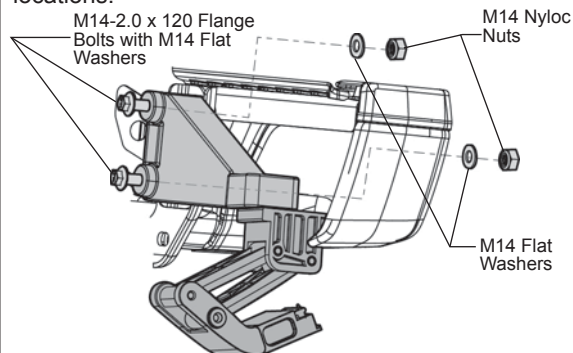
3 Assemble Linkage to Mounting Bracket

Mount the Linkage to the holes closest to the bumper.



4 Install Linkage Assembly

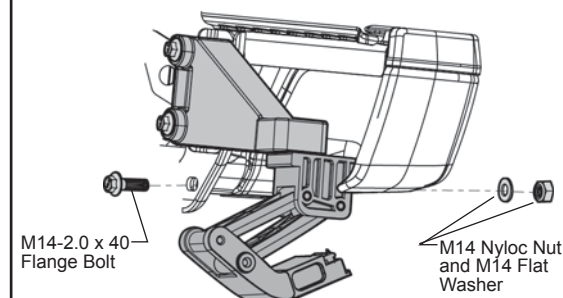
Use two (2) M14-2.0 x 120 Hex Bolts, four (4) M14 Flat Washers and two (2) M14 Nyloc Nuts to secure the Linkage Assembly to the bumper mounting locations.



5 Secure Linkage Assembly

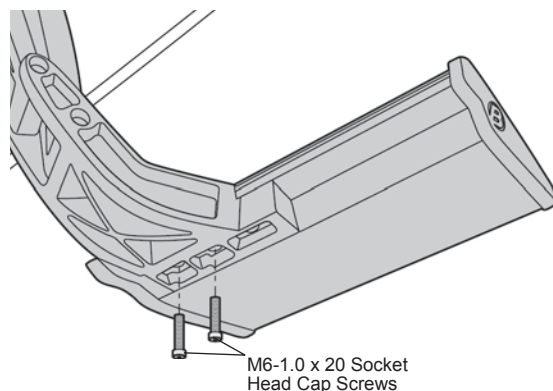
Use the M14-2.0 x 40mm Flange Bolt, and the remaining M14 Flat Washer and M14 Nyloc Nut to secure the Linkage Assembly to the bumper.

NOTE If vehicle does not have factory hitch, skip this step.



6 Install Step

Use the M6-1.0 x 20 Socket Head Cap Screws to mount the Step to the Linkage Assembly.

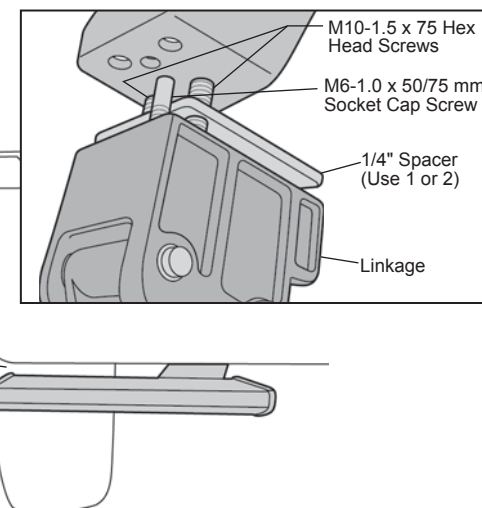


7 Adjust Step

Adjust the Step from side to side. Make sure to leave clearance for foot access to lower step. Tighten the allen head bolts.

If the step is hitting the vehicle or if you want it to be lower add one or two of the supplied spacers. Remove the M10-1.5 X 65 screw installed in step 3. Place shims between the Linkage and Mounting bracket and reattach using the M10-1.5 X 75 Hex Head Screws and M6-1.0 x 50 mm or M6-1.0 x 75 mm Socket Cap Screw.

Allow foot access to lower step



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Operation

- The TrekStep™ is foot operated and deploys and retracts with a nudge of your foot.
- To deploy, press down using your left foot, on the forward outside corner of the step pad.
- To retract, gently kick the underside of the step pad.
- Max Load Capacity: 300 lbs.
- Always use appropriate hand holds when stepping up to or down from your truck's cargo bed.

Care and Maintenance

The step pad surface and linkage arms should be washed with mild soap and water using a soft brush or sponge to dislodge any mud, dirt or accumulated road grime. Rinse with fresh water. After it is dry, lubricate the hinge with 3-IN-ONE Oil.

To prevent slipping, avoid applying waxes, lubricants or protectants like Armor All® to the step surface.
