
Install body mount bracket.

Slide bracket over the bed bolt and hand tighten a M14 washer and M14 nylock nut onto bed bolt.

Slide other end of assembled universal bracket over locking block screw.



Install board assembly onto linkage and secure with 4 M6 x 20 mm socket cap screws. Board should be centered on linkage and can be adjusted in the next step.

STEP 12

Adjust the Step from side to side. Make sure to leave clearance for foot access to lower step. Tighten the allen head bolts.

If the step is hitting the vehicle or if you want it to be lower add one to three (1 - 2) of the supplied spacers. Remove the M10-1.5 X 45 screw and M6 x 30 cap screw installed in step 2. Place shims between the Linkage and Mounting bracket and reattach using the M10-1.5 X 45 Hex Head Screws and M6X30 mm screws.

with a nudge of your foot.

To deploy, press down using your foot, on the forward

outside corner of the step pad.

- To retract, gently kick the underside of the step pad.
