

## **BX2318 Installation Instructions** 2003 Hyundai Tiburon GT

Strong As An Ox" The headlight assembly, front fascia and tie down brackets are removed for baseplate installation. Tie down brackets will be reinstalled. No drilling is required. Trimming of air dam below metal bumper is required. The BX8869 is available for the vehicle. Attachment Tabs are 24 inches center to center and a height of 14 1/2 inches.



1. Remove the four push pins (black arrows) and three phillips screws (white arrows) along the back edge of black plastic cover on top side of fascia with the phillips screw driver. Llft cover and set aside.



3. Remove two phillips push pins from lower edge of fascia just forward of front tires, both sides.



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5. Remove the metric bolt from the head light assembly with the 10MM socket, pull forward, unplug and set aside, both sides.



2. Remove two metric bolts just forward of front tire on corner of fascia and edge of wheel well with the 8MM and 10MM socket, both sides.



4. Remove two metric bolts from the top side of head light assembly with the 10MM socket, both sides.





6. Just below headlight assembly is one metric bolt to remove with the 10MM socket and one phillips push pin to remove, both sides.

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7. Remove one phillips push pin from the underside of grill opening with the phillips screw driver, both sides, pull fascia forward and carefully set aside.



- 9. Using the reciprocating saw, make a horizontal cut on rib at the end of frame just below metal bumper and one just above lower offset, both sides (see arrows in photo). Make a vertical cut between the top and lower horizontal cuts flush against the side of frame rail, both sides. This will allow the baseplate to slide onto frame rail.
- **11.** Drill the self tapping screws into webbing on frame end with the 5/16" nut driver, as shown in photo, both sides.



8. Remove the three metric bolts from tie down bracket with the 17MM socket, both sides. Using the reciprocating saw, cut support rib on the side of frame just behind frame end and bend rib down flat against frame with a hammer, both sides.



**10.** Spray paint the cut edges of ribbing on both sides with a fast drying spray paint to prevent corrosion.



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- 12. Slide baseplate onto frame rail to align with existing holes for tie down bracket. Reattach tie down brackets and tighten 10MM bolts, lock and flat washers, according to drawing on page 4, both sides, while maintaining a level position with vehicle. Be sure to use loctite red on all bolts before tightening. Tighten all bolts according to Torque Chart in General Instruction Sheet. NOTE: Baseplate is painted white to increase visibility in photos.
- **13.** Using the utility knife, cut out the marked area on the air dam, both sides. Reinstall the air dams.
- 14. Reinstall the fascia and headlight assemblies. Be sure all electrical components are plugged in properly.
- **15.** The dimensional variations between otherwise identical cars can be considerable. While the location and size of the holes in the baseplate were designed to allow for easy installation, it may be necessary to file a hole slightly to allow a bolt to clear.

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- **16.** Install the tow bar and safety cables according to the instructions included in their packages.
- **17.** Do **not** substitute other devices if the tow bar pin and clip are lost.
- 18. DEALER OR INSTALLER: BE CERTAIN THE USER RECEIVES THE INSTRUCTION SHEET.


