

PROCEDURE:

REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION. BUMPER IS HEAVY, ASSISTANCE IS RECOMMENDED TO AVOID POSSIBLE INJURY OR DAMAGE TO THE VEHICLE. INSTALLATION WILL INTERFERE WITH BLIND SPOT ALERT AND REAR CROSS TRAFFIC ALERT SYSTEMS.

- Locate BSM button next to the steering wheel to turn off the Blind-Spot Monitor (BSM) and Rear Cross Traffic Alert (RCTA) Systems, (if equipped). Next, unplug the wire harnesses from the (2) monitor sensors located on the rear ends of the Rear Bumper. NOTE: The BSM and RCTA systems will not work with Bumper installation, monitor sensors cannot be reinstalled with Bumper.


(Fig 1) Unplug and remove 7-wire trailer plug

- Remove the license plate from the bumper. Next, unplug the license plate lights, trailer plug and sensors, (if equipped) (Figure 1). Release the wiring harness from the clips attached to the back of the bumper. Move all wiring harnesses away from bumper.
- 3. Determine if vehicle is equipped with factory receiver hitch:
 - Models with Factory Receiver Hitch
 - **a.** Use a flat blade screwdriver to pry the plastic cover from the top of the rear bumper on the passenger and driver side edge (**Figure 3**).




(Fig 4) Remove plastic screw previously under the license plate.

 - **b.** Remove the plastic screw previously under the license plate (Figure 4). Release the clips and factory hardware under the passenger and driver side of the bumper and proceed to remove the center plastic piece on top of the bumper (Figure 5 & 6A).
 - **c.** Place blocks or jack stands under the receiver hitch to support it during mounting bolt removal. Once the bumper has been safely supported, remove the factory hardware attaching the bumper to the top and bottom of the receiver hitch and remove the bumper (**Figure 6B**). **NOTE**: Leave hitch attached to vehicle.

d. Select the Passenger/Right Mounting Bracket and attach it to the four holes in the receiver hitch with the same (4) factory bolts, (Figures 7 & 8). Snug but do not fully tighten at this time. Repeat this Step to attach the Driver/Left Mounting Bracket on the driver side

Models without Factory Receiver Hitch

- **a.** Place blocks or jack stands under the bumper to support it during mounting bolt removal. Once the bumper has been safely supported, remove the factory hardware attaching the bumper to the frame and remove the bumper (**Figure 2**).
- b. Select the Passenger Support Bracket. Attach the Bracket to frame with (2) 14mm Hex Bolts, (4) 14mm Flat Washers, (2) 14mm Lock Washers, and (2) 14mm Hex Nuts, (Figures 9 & 10).
- **c.** Next, select the Passenger/Right Mounting Bracket. Attach the Bracket to the outside of the frame and Support Bracket with (4) 14mm Hex Bolts, (8) 14mm Flat Washers, (4) 14mm Lock Washers, and (4) 14mm Hex Nuts (Figure 11). Snug but do not fully tighten at this time.
- d. Repeat Steps 3b & 3c for Driver/left side Bracket installation.
- 4. With assistance, position the Bumper Assembly up to the Mounting Brackets. Temporarily support the weight of the Bumper. **WARNING**: To avoid possible injury or damage to the vehicle, do not proceed until the bumper is fully and safely supported.
- Attach the Bumper Bracket to the end of the Passenger/Right Mounting Bracket with the included (2) 12mm Hex Bolts, (2) 12mm Lock Washers and (2) 12mm Flat Washers, (Figures 12A & 12B). Repeat this Step to attach the Driver side Bumper Bracket to the Driver/Left Mounting Bracket. Do not fully tighten hardware at this time.
- 6. Level and adjust the Bumper and fully tighten all hardware.
- 7. Reinstall the trailer plug, (Figure 13). NOTE: Use a flat blade screwdriver to carefully pry the metal clip on the plug out to grab the edge of the opening.
- Use the included (2) License Plate Plugs to attach the rear license plate to the (2) holes in the Bumper, (Figure 13). Insert the License Plate Light into the hole in the bumper, (Figure 13). Attach the License Plate Light wire to the end of the factory license plate light wire harness.
- **9.** Determine if the bumper is equipped with back up sensors.

Models with bumper mounted back up sensors:


- **a.** Push the sensor in from the back of the bumper. Secure each sensor to the socket with (2) 4mm Button Head Screws, **(Figure 14)**. **IMPORTANT**: Sensors fit snug in sockets. The 4mm Screws are used to apply slight pressure to lock the sensors in place. Tighten both screws evenly until they touch the sensor body only. Do not overtighten screws or damage to sensors will result.
- **b.** Reattach the factory wiring harness to sensors.

Models without bumper mounted sensors:


- **a.** Push the (4) sensor plugs in from the back of the bumper.
- 10. LED light installation at ends of bumper as supplied with bumper or sold separately.
 - **a.** Insert light into opening and up to mounting slots. Check for clearance between front and back of light. If necessary, remove the screen from the back of the opening for additional clearance or access to light, (Figure 15).
 - **b.** Follow the light manufacturer's instructions to attach (1) light to the slot.
 - c. Repeat the above steps for driver side light installation.
 - **d.** Follow light manufacturer's instructions to properly wire the light.
- **11.** Attach the wiring harness to the trailer plug.
- **12.** Use the included Wire Ties to secure the wiring harness to bumper and frame as necessary.
- 13. Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.

To protect your investment, wax this product after installing. Regular waxing is recommended to add a protective layer over the finish. Do not use any type of polish or wax that may contain abrasives that could damage the finish. Mild soap may be used to clean the Bumper assembly.


Passenger Side Installation Pictured

WARNING! Do not remove bumper bolts unless the bumper is properly supported on blocks or stands or the bumper may fall.
