

Use & Care Instructions

Thank you for your purchase of our Cargo Area Liner.

Both the Universal and Custom-Patterned units are constructed of a very durable fabric that will provide good protection to the cargo area of your vehicle.



Installing the Cargo Area Liner is easy.

- First attach the strap and clip around the headrest or the headrest post and adjust the tightness by pulling on the loose end of the strap. Side release buckles are included with the straps for easy removal.

- **For Universal Cargo Liners** spread the liner over the area from side to side and front to back.

- **For Custom-Patterned Cargo Liners** spread the liner over the area from side to side and front to back and then move to the rear of the vehicle and secure the tie straps to the available anchor points in the vehicle. The pattern may not use all the anchor points, but be sure to tie the webbing to the selected locations.

Be sure to fold the bumper flap **UNDER** the cargo liner when not in use (Custom-Patterned Cargo Liners only). When you are using the cargo liner raise the bumper flap **UP** after you load the vehicle. The bumper flap will help protect the inside of the tailgate.

Your Cargo Area Liner is simple to maintain and a quick shake will normally be enough to remove surface dirt.

The Cargo Area Liner may also be spot-cleaned if required. It's best to lay the cover on the driveway or lawn. **NOTE:** not all types of soiling will be able to be removed, test a small area first.

- 1 - Mix one ounce Simple Green All-Purpose Cleaner per quart of warm water.
- 2 - Spray or sponge onto cover.
- 3 - Rinse with plain water (until no suds) and allow to air dry.
