



ASSEMBLY







Step 1

Remove the underbody panel from the passenger side of the vehicle by removing three push fasteners and three screws using a 10mm socket.





Step 2

Remove the three hole plugs and clean the weldnuts in each frame rail.





Step 3

Raise the trailer hitch into position and secure with three M12 hex bolts (#1) and conical-toothed washers (#2) on each side.





Step 4

Torque all M12 bolts to 86 lb-ft.





Step 5

Trim the underbody panel using the groves on the panel as guides. A trim diagram is provided for reference.

Reinstall the panel using the factory hardware.
