Periodic inspection of your product should be performed


to ensure all hardware and / or components remain secure.








Step 1

Remove the old fork mounts from the cargo basket, if installed.






Step 2

Install the replacement adapters.

Note that the adapters can be flipped around for either 100 mm or 110 mm spacing. Verify your fork spacing before installing.






Step 3

Insert the appropriate bushing.

For 9mm axles, insert the bushing with the groove. For 12mm axles, insert the bushing with no groove. For 15mm axles, no bushing is required.



Step 4

Insert the quick release through the bushing.

Note: The quick release is only suitable for 9mm axles. For 12mm and 15mm thru axles, re-use the bike axle.

Wrap the safety strap around the rear tire and cargo rack to secure the rear of the bike. Feed the end of the strap into the buckle and tighten.
