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
1. Remove plastic fascia from rear of vehicle to gain access to hitch mounting locations. First, remove (2) screws from plastic mounting brackets using a T-25 Torxbit socket. Then, un-clip plastic from vehicle and gently pull back to remove.





2. Fishwire (2) 1/2"carriage bolts and spacer blocks through driver side access hole in bumper beam.





### **INSTALLATION WALKTHROUGH:**

3. Slide mounting plate assembly up behind the frame mounting lip. Ensure the plate is sitting flush on the back of the mounting surface with the weld nuts pointing toward the front of the vehicle.






4. Raise hitch into position, securing to 1/2" fishwired hardware and to the 1/2" weldnuts in the mounting plate.


Torque all 1/2" hardware to 110 lb-ft.



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5. Mark and trim both heat shield and plastic rear fascia as shown. Bend heat sheild up into its concealed position. Reattach plastic fascia by clipping back onto vehicle and securing both screws on sides of vehicle.



## INSTALLATION STEPS

- 1. Remove plastic fascia from rear of vehicle to gain access to hitch mounting locations. First, remove (2) screws from plastic mounting brackets using a T-25 Torxbit socket. Then, un-clip plastic from vehicle and gently pull back to remove.
- 2. Fishwire (2) 1/2"carriage bolts and spacer blocks through driver side access hole in bumper beam.
- 3. Slide mounting plate assembly up behind the frame mounting lip. Ensure the plate is sitting flush on the back of the mounting surface with the weld nuts pointing toward the front of the vehicle.
- Raise hitch into position, securing to 1/2" fishwired hardware and to the 1/2" weldnuts in the mounting plate. Torgue all 1/2" hardware to 110 lb-ft.
- 5. Mark and trim both heat sheild and plastic rear fascia as needed. Bend heat shield up into its concealed position. Reattach plastic fascia by clipping back onto vehicle and securing both screws on sides of vehicle.
