

### INSTALLATION

### Step 1

Position the hitch to the underside of the original vehicle step plate.

### Step 2

Use existing holes if present. If existing holes cannot be used, mark and drill holes for two 3/4" bolts and two 1/2" bolts.

### Step 3

Assemble using two  $3/4" \times 3"$  (#1) bolts and 3/4" flange nuts (#2) on the outer holes and two  $1/2" \times 2"$  bolts (#3) and 1/2" flange nuts (#4) on the inner holes.

### Step 4

Spacers (#5) for the 3/4" bolts are provided. Only use these spacers if there is a welded tab on the underside of the bumper. It is very important to tighten all nuts securely.
