
¹/₂" Drive Socket Wrench with 3" Extension, socket set, ¹/₂" Drive Torque Wrench and a wrench set.

IV. Removal of OEM tow hooks

- 1. From underneath the vehicle, undo the OEM towhook fasteners. For each tow hook there should be one vertical bolt as well a one long bolt and nut going through the end of the frame rail.
- 2. From the front of the vehicle, slide the tow hooks out through the openings in the front bumper.

V. Installation of Fab Fours Winch Mount

1. Review the exploded parts view above

2. Install the included tow hooks to the bottom of the Fab Fours winch mount with the provided hardware. In this step you should be using the longer, 2-1/2" bolts. Be sure to use a washer under each bolt head as well as a washer and lock washer under each nut.

3. Install the large frame winch (Customer Supplied).

4. With the assistance of a lifting aid or additional helpers, lift the winch mount into position so that the mounts are aligned with the tow hook openings in the OEM bumper.

5. Carefully slide the mounts through the bumper and into the ends of the frame rails.

6. Install 1/2" bolts (included) through the sides of the mounts, one on either side of each frame rail. Be sure to include a washer and lock washer under the head of each bolt.

7. Install two more 1/2" bolts (included) into the bottom of the frame rail, using the included washer plates on the bottom side of the frame rail. Be sure to include a washer and lock washer under the head of each bolt.

8. Check for satisfactory alignment, then tighten all hardware.
