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














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IV. Vehicle Preparation




Figure 1 - WHEEL WELL FASTENER LOCATIONS

1. Using a small flat head screwdriver, remove the plastic rivet in the lower corner of each rear wheel well by inserting the screwdriver into the recess and prying the head outward. See Figure 1.

2. Using a 7mm socket and ratchet, Remove the two (2) screw fasteners from each wheel attaching the rear bumper cover to the inner fender liner

- **3.** Open the rear lift gate and remove the two plastic push rivets from below the center of the door with a small flat head screwdriver or plastic rivet removal tool.
- **4.** Remove the four (4) remaining screws from the door sill with a 7mm socket and ratchet.




Figure 2 – DOOR SILL FASTENER LOCATION



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5. Detach the rear bumper cover from the lower support brackets by removing the screw fastener with a 10mm socket and ratchet. See below for fastener location:




Figure 3 – LOWER SUPPORT FASTENER LOCATION – VIEW FROM BELOW

6. Reaching behind the bumper cover at the outer corner, firmly pull the cover outward to release it from the fastening clips. Repeat for other side




Figure 4 - CORNER CLIP RELEASE



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7. Pull rearward on the bumper cover to remove it from the truck.




Figure 5 – BUMPER COVER REMOVAL

- **8.** If your vehicle is equipped with Park Assist Radar, the wiring harness must be disconnected passenger side of the bumper before it can be fully removed.
- **9.** Remove three (3) fasteners attaching the the bumper cover clipping brackets to the bottom of the fenders with a 10mm socket. See below for fastener location:




Figure 6 - CLIPPING BRACKET REMOVAL - VIEW FRM BELOW



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10. The disassembly of the vehicle is now complete.

Optional: Removal of the spare tire will increase accessibility to Fab Fours bumper adjustment points during the installation.



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V. Bumper Installation

NOTE: The Following Installation steps apply to the installation of your Fab Fours HD Rear Bumper. **PLEASE READ THE ENTIRE MANUAL BEFORE ATEMPTING INSTALLATION!** Ignoring these steps will increase your probability of damaging the vehicle and/or bumper, as well as decreasing the overall quality of the installation!

- 1. Fully unpack and inspect all of the components included with your Fab Fours HD rear bumper
- 2. With the help of another person, lift the bumper weldment into position on the vehicle. The bumper will rest on top of the OEM Hitch.




Figure 7 – BUMPER INSTALLATION – SIDE VIEW



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3. With the bumper being steadied by the installation helper, tilt the bumper forward to allow the body mounting tabs on the fender wells to pass over top of the Fab Fours bumper end caps. With the end cap on the wheel side of the body mounting tab, loosely secure the bumper in place with the OEM fastener. See image below:




Figure 8 – BODY MOUNTING TAB

4. Check the gap between the fender and the bumper wing. See image below.




Figure 9 - BUMPER GAP MEASUREMENT



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5. If the gap at the tail light is larger than 5/8" the Fab Fours provided spacer plates can be placed in between the OEM hitch and the bumper mounting plates to reduce the gap. Insert the plates from the back side of the bumper. See image below:

NOTE: If the gap at the taillights is 3/8" or less, do not use these spacers to prevent paint or sheet metal damage in normal operation.




Figure 10 - TOP SPACER INSTALLATION - VIEW FROM BELOW

6. Remove the hitch mounting screws from the side of both frame rails with an 18mm socket and ratchet. These fasteners are installed with Loctite at the factory, so a breaker bar and extra force may be required:




Figure 11 - HITCH MOUNTING SCREW REMOVAL - VIEW FROM BELOW



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7. Loosely reinstall the hitch mounting screws with the Fab Fours provided bumper mounting brackets as shown below. The outer face of the bumper is removed from the view for clarity:




Figure 12 - OUTER BRAKCET INSTALLATION – VIEW FROM BELOW PASSENGER FRAME RAIL

- 8. Loosely install the remaining fasteners for both of the outer brackets.
 - a. The outer holes use the Fab Fours provided stud plates with ½" flat washers, ½" lock washers, and ½" hex nuts. Stud plates should be installed from the top, allowing access to the nuts from below.
 - b. Holes though the top face use ½" x 1.5" hex bolts with ½" flat washers, ½" lock washers, and ½" hex nuts. Run the bolts down from the top of the bumper to maximize clearance to the lift gate.




Figure 1 - OUTER BRACKET FASTENER INSTALLATION - VIEW FROM BELOW PASSENGER FRAME RAIL



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- 9. Slowly close the lift gate to verify clearance to the bumper and fasteners. With the lift gate closed, center the bumper so the gap on either side is equal.
- 10. Reopen the lift gate.
- 11. Install four self-tapping screws into the pre-existing holes in the OEM hitch assembly through the mounting plates accessed through the clearance holes in the top face of the bumper with a 3/8" socket and ratchet:




Figure 13 - TOP FASTENER INSTALLATION

- 12. Verify that the bumper has not shifted during fastening. Re-adjust if necessary, then tighten the outer mounting bracket fasteners, starting with the OEM hitch fasteners (18mm socket and ratchet), then moving to the fasteners through the top face (3/4" socket and ratchet, 3/4" wrench), and tightening the outer fasteners last (3/4" socket and ratchet).
- 13. Loosely install the Fab Fours provided lower support brackets with provided 7/16" x 1.5" hex bolts, 7/16" flat washers, 7/16" lock washers, and 7/16" hex nuts though the lower edge of the bumper as shown below.




Figure 14 - LOWER SUPPORT BRACKET INSTALLATION - VIEW FROM BELOW



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- 14. Drill pilot holes though the three (3) mounting holes into the hitch beam with a 17/64" drill bit. Repeat for both lower support brackets
- 15. Install three self-tapping screws per bracket into the drilled holes with a 3/8" socket and ratchet.

NOTE: If you did not use the provided spacer to adjust the installation height of the bumper in step 5, then you will need to use the spacer shown in the image below to correct the height of the bracket. If you did use the spacer in step 5, then the spacer is not required for the lower bracket.




Figure 15 - SELF-TAPPING FASTENER INSTALLATION - VIEW FROM BELOW

- 16. Fully tighten the 7/16" bolts in the lower edge of the lower edge of the bumper with a 5/8" socket, ratchet, and 11/16" wrench.
- 17. Install the provided round hole plugs into the access holes to the top fasteners and the provided square hole plug into the spare tire access hole.




Figure 16 - PANEL PLUG INSTALLATION



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- 18. **OPTIONAL:** Trim the inner fender liners to match the higher clearance of your Fab Fours bumper. This can be done with a body saw, rotary tool, or sharp utility knife (New blade strongly recommended). **USE CAUTION WHEN PERFORMING ANY CUTTING OPERATION TO PREVENT VEHICLE DAMAGE OR PERSONAL INJURY.**
- 19. **OPTIONAL:** Hardware and mounting provisions are provided to reattach the inner fender liner to you Fab Fours bumper if desired. It is recommended that vehicles that perform in severe duty environments or spend a significant amount of time off-highway that the inner fender liner NOT be attached to the Fab Fours bumper, as it may cause damage to the inner fender liner mounting due to chassis flex. For severe duty vehicles, the body mounting screw installed in step 3 should also be removed.



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VI. Maintenance/Care

	Periodically	check and	tighten	all	fasteners.
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- ☐ Stripped, fractured, or bent bolts or nuts need to be replaced.
- ☐ Keep all surfaces free of dirt, road grime, and standing water to ensure finish longevity.


