

Thank you for purchasing one of our fine quality products. Your seat cover is engineered from high quality materials and designed with precision to give you a long-lasting, well-adjusted fit.

A) BACKREST COVER - 40 PORTION:

- 1) Unlatch backrest.
- 2) Remove headrest (see note)
- 3) Undo velcro on cover
- 4) Slip cover over backrest and place latch through opening provided
- 5) Pull down firmly and tuck bottom of cover through crevice
- 6) Fold backrest down flat
- 7) Bring bottom cover from crevice and velcro to back of seat cover
- 8) Adjust all velcro to equalize tension
- 9) Replace headrest (see note)

B) BACKREST COVER - 60 PORTION:

- 1) Unlatch backrest
- 2) Remove headrest (see note)
- 3) Undo zipper and velcro on cover
- 4) Slip cover over backrest and place latch through opening provided.
- 5) Ensure cover is under center seat belt strap and place armrest through opening on cover
- 6) Tuck flap on cover behind armrest and velcro

- 7) Pull down firmly and tuck bottom of cover through crevice
- 8) Fold backrest down flat
- 9) Apply side velcro behind the backrest carpeting
- 10) Close zipper and bring bottom cover from crevice and velcro to back of seat cover
- 11) Adjust all velcro to equalize tension
- 12) Replace headrest (see note)

C) ARMREST COVER:

1) Undo velcro on cover

2) Slip cover over armrest and velcro. Cover has opening for pull tab

D) CUSHION COVER - 40 PORTION:

- 1) Center cover over cushion
- 2) Tuck back flap through crevice
- 3) Pass the back straps under seat to front and buckle
- 4) Pass the side straps and buckle to other side (See note)
- 5) Adjust all straps to equalize tension

E) CUSHION COVER - 60 PORTION:

- 1) Center cover over cushion
- 2) Place seat belt buckle through opening provided
- 3) Tuck back flap through crevice

- 4) Pass the back straps under seat to front and buckle
- 5) Pass the side straps and buckle to other side (See note)
- 6) Adjust all straps to equalize tension

NOTES:

1) SELF-LOCKING SUPER-GRIP® BUCKLE:




2) HEAD REST REMOVAL:

- A) Insert paper clip into holes at base to release
 - Lift off

<u>OR</u>

- B) Push in side release buttons
- Lift off

(If unable to remove consult dealership)



3) RE-INSTALLATION OF HEADRESTS

- A) Ensure pre-cut holes in seat cover align with holes in headrest base.
- B) Replace headrests

4) ZIPPERS

For ease in installation the zipper is longer than the cover. Tuck excess zipper under cover

WARNING: SEATS WITH INTEGRATED SEAT AIRBAGS MUST BE COVERED ONLY WITH SEATCOVERS DESIGNED WITH OPENINGS THAT WILL NOT INTERFERE WITH THE DEPLOYMENT OF THE AIRBAG. NEVER INSTALL SEAT COVERS WITHOUT THESE OPENINGS AS THIS MAY INTERFERE WITH THE PROPER DEPLOYMENT OF THE AIR BAGS AND COULD RESULT IN SERIOUS INJURY.
