Thank you for purchasing one of our fine quality products. Your seat cover is engineered from high quality materials and designed with precision to give you a long-lasting, well-adjusted fit.

A) CUSHION COVER - 40 PORTIONS

- 1) Release seat belt buckle from elastic holder
- 2) Center cover on the seat
- 3) With seat in highest position, pass back straps under seat through crevice and buckle to front
- 4) Pass long side strap through the opening between the molded
- plastic and the seat. Buckle to opposite side 5) replace seat belt buckle to elastic on cover
- 6) Adjust straps and buckles to equalize tension

B) BACKREST COVER - 40 PORTIONS

- 1) Remove head rest (see note)
- 2) Slip cover over backrest. (see air bag warning below)
- 3) Tuck flaps under backrest and attach to Velcro at back
- 4) Adjust Velcro to equalize tension
- 5) Replace headrests (see note)

C) CUSHION COVER - 20 PORTION

- 1) Open cushion lid to up position
- 2) Slip cover over lid and attach velcro strips
- 3) With cushion lid closed, pass back flap through crevice between seat and plastic molding
- 4) Open cushion lid to up position
- 5) Pull back flap and apply velcro to carpet
- 6) Snug and adjust velcro for a better fit

D) BACKREST COVER - 20 PORTION

- 1) Remove headrest (see note)
- 2) Undo velcro on cover and open zipper
- 3) Slip cover over backrest and under seat belt and close zipper
- 4) Snug cover at back attach velcro
- 5) Position adhesive velcro supplied to align with velcro on cover around the edge of cup holder. **NOTE: BEFORE POSITIONING VELCRO**, CLEAN AREA WITH ALCOHOL SWAB PROVIDED.
- 6) Adjust all velcro to equalize tension
- 7) Replace headrest (see note)


3) RE-INSTALLATION OF HEADRESTS

- A) Ensure pre-cut holes in seat cover align with holes in headrest base.
- B) Replace headrests

2) HEAD REST REMOVAL:

- Push in side release buttons
- Lift off
