

<u>IMPORTANT!!</u> – Keep bolts hand tight until all brackets are fastened together as one unit or you will have a hard time lining up all the holes in the brackets.

<u>Step 1:</u> DO NOT REMOVE FACTORY CHROME BUMPER!! **Tow hook models**: Remove tow hook and any plastic around tow hook. **Non tow hook models**: remove plastic in bumper to expose the truck frame plate. Mount BRACKET 1 to open bolt holes in bumper face plate.

Step 2: Attach BRACKET 2 using 14mm bolt to the threaded nut welded on the inside/bottom of the frame.

<u>Step 3:</u> Attach BRACKET 3 to upper hole of BRACKET 1 and 2 as shown in picture. When this is done it should become obvious where BRACKET 3 attaches on the vertical OEM frame post welded to the bottom of truck frame.

Step 4: Double check spacing of bracket and opening in factory chrome bumper then FINISH TIGHTENING ALL BOLTS!

Step 5: Attach Frontier Grille Guard to BRACKET1, align vertically and horizontally and tighten.

Note: License plate can be re-located by removing plastic license plate backing and reattach ONLY the plate higher up using the ¼" bolts provided.
