# **BEFORE STARTING**

Your vehicle must be raised a minimum of 36 inches. A floor hoist is ideal. If no hoist is available, we strongly urge the use of axle stands as a safety measure.

## CAUTION! YOUR CAR SHOULD NOT BE SUPPORTED ON A BUMPER JACK.

# INSTALLATION PROCEDURE: PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

<u>NOTE:</u> All HOOKER mufflers feature aluminized and stainless steel construction for long life. The following tips are intended to help you realize the full potential of these mufflers.

- HOOKER mufflers are designed with a heavy gauge inlet and outlet stub for high strength. Standard muffler clamps will not
  properly crush the stub and welding is recommended IN ALL CASES.
- 2. Proper support of the exhaust system components is essential to long life. Mufflers should be supported as near the outlet as possible (See Illustration A.)
- 3. All exhaust system mounts should contain a rubber isolator to dampen vibration and prevent metal fatigue and cracking. Various types of mounts are available (See Illustration B for several examples.)
- 4. Following the above procedures should provide you with excellent service and long life from your HOOKER mufflers.

When finished, give your car a test drive checking carefully for any new noises. After several days driving, retighten all the bolts.





