

2016+ Cadillac ATS-V Installation Instructions



Do not attempt this installation if proper safety equipment isn't available to you. Seek the assistance of a professional installer.

Kooks 2016+ Cadillac Turbo Downpipe install from underneath the vehicle. Raising and securing the vehicle with jack stands is a must if a lift is not available.

VEHICLE PREPARATION

Raise and Support Vehicle (Refer to Owner's Manual for specified jacking points)

Always disconnect the negative battery terminal before performing this type of work on any vehicle



STOCK EXHAUST REMOVAL PROCESS

It is a good idea to spray WD-40 on the rusted hardware before you start to help loosen them. While the lube is doing its job, you can start the install.

STEP 1. Battery

• Disconnect the negative and positive battery terminal.

STEP 2. O2 Sensors

- Note and mark the position of each O2 sensor.
- Disconnect all O2 sensors from wiring harness.
- Remove O2 sensors (⁷/₈" wrench or O2 socket).

STEP 3. Trim Factory Connection

- Carefully cut the exhaust piping just in front of the rear hangers
- Cut approximately 6 3/16" in front of the rear hanger on the Driver side and 6" in front of the rear hanger on the Passenger side. See Figure A.

STEP 4. Factory Downpipe

- Remove the factory catalytic convertor bracket (2 Bolts). (This will not be reused.)
- Unbolt downpipe from manifold (4 bolts on each side)

STEP 5. Center Cross Bracket

- Remove the center cross bracket (4 bolts) This is in front of the X-Pipe.
- Once this is removed the entire exhaust will drop out.



KOOKS TURBO DOWNPIPE INSTALLATION PROCESS

All hardware should be tightened to factory specifications

STEP 1. Cleaning.

• Before installing your new Kooks Turbo Downpipes, make sure all gasket surfaces are clean and oil free.

STEP 2. Kooks Downpipes

- Install driver and passenger downpipe from the bottom of the engine compartment
- Tighten downpipe to factory torque specs using factory torque spec sequence.

STEP 3. Kooks Connection Pipes

- Loosely install connection pipes on vehicle using supplied band clamps and barrel clamps.
- The (4) 3" band clamps are for the "front connections" and "mid pipe" connection pipe.
- The (2) 2 3/4" Barrel clamp is located at the OEM connection
- Align system for maximum clearance.
- Tighten system from rear to front of the vehicle.

STEP 4. O2 Sensors

- Apply anti seize to the threads of all O2 sensors.
- Install O2 sensors noting their original location.

STEP 5. Battery


- Ensure all above steps have been completed.
- Reconnect the positive then the negative battery terminal.


STEP 6. Inspection

- Start engine and check for any exhaust leaks.
- Allow vehicle to complete one heat cycle (Heat to temp and allow for cooling).
- Wait for exhaust to fully cool before handling.
- Re-torque bolts and hardware.
