Congratulations, you have purchased the finest air filter that money can buy. With proper care, this filter will last 1 million miles or more. This filter is a direct replacement for the stock air filter, and no modifications will be required. However the following procedure MUST be followed to ensure a proper fit and seal of the K&N Air Filter.

## **Tools Required:**

1/4" Drive Ratchet 5/16" Socket

1/4 " Drive Extension Small Flat Blade Screwdriver

1/4" Socket

## Installation

- 1. Remove the hose clamp on the air box with a flat blade screwdriver (see Fig 1a and 1b). Disconnect the tube from the airbox lid (Fig. 2).
- 2. Unfasten the two screws (Fig. 3) that hold the airbox lid to the airbox base with a 5/16 socket and remove the lid from the vehicle.
- 3. Remove the stock air filter from the airbox base.
- 4. With a damp rag wipe off any dirt or grease from the inside of the airbox. The airbox must be clean and dry so the gasket will stick to the lid.
- 5. Install the self-adhering gasket to the airbox lid. (Fig. 4)
- 6. Install the K&N Air Filter into the airbox base.
- 7. Re-install the airbox lid and fasten the two screws.
- 8. Re-install the air intake tube, with the supplied hose clamp (Fig. 5), onto the airbox lid and tighten the hose clamp.

## THESE INSTRUCTIONS MUST BE FOLLOWED EVERY TIME THE FILTER IS SERVICED, OTHERWISE THE FILTER MAY NOT SEAL, AND DAMAGE TO THE ENGINE COULD RESULT.








